A new bridge on the narrow-gauge road near Lathrop, Iowa, gave way Monday, carrying down an engine and two cars.

The bill permitting the construction of a bridge over the Missouri river at Arrow Rock, has passed the house as amended in the senate.

A Geneva cablegram reports the kidnapping of a child of a leading family, and its death in a distant land, unless a ransom of 50,000 francs is sent.

In a snowdrift at Genoa, Nov. 18, Mrs. Brown, Miss Berlin, and from seven to twenty Indians were killed. Some of the bodies have been recovered.

The house has passed the anti-Chinese bill. There were 65 votes against it, 61 of which were republicans. Gen. Rosecrans says that this vote gives California to the democrats.

The contest of striking operatives in Omaha still continues, though somewhat subdued by the United States troops sent for by the governor. One of the strikers was killed.

The author of the bitter attack on Gen. Garfield which we copied from the Washington Post, proves to be William Brown, of Kentucky, a delegate to the Chicago convention, and a Blaine man.

Two companies of Nebraska militia have been relieved from guard duty, and four companies of regulars will at once return to Camp Sigbee. Grading on the Burlington and Missouri contract is carried on with a flourish.

A party of masked citizens of Rawlins, Wyoming, took three sale-robbers from jail and lynched two of them, the other making his escape. These Knights of the Black Caps will be observed live north of Mason and Dixon's line.

There seems to be a general ferment of the work-people of the country, in some degree an impetus to that troubles at Omaha. It is thought that there will be numerous strikes as soon as spring business sets in, in earnest.

A friend of Roscoe Conkling's says he will accept nothing from this administration; that his ambition is to be once more returned to the senate from New York, and that in the mean time he intends to make some money in his profession.
