DOUTINGO SANTA MARIA has been elected President of Chile.
THE New York Greenbackers will hold a State Convention at Elmira, August 27.
COL. JOHN C. BURCH, Secretary of the United States Senate, died at Washington, D. C., on the 29th.
A REBEL is in circulation that Gould has purchased the Atchafalaya and Nebraska road as a feeder to the Union Pacific.
OWING to the unsettled state of Ireland it has been decided to maintain military establishments at their present strength some time longer.
MIHAT PASHA, and all others convicted of the murder of the late Sultan, except the two actual assassins, have been banished for life to Siberia.
SECRETARY WISDOM has instructed the Collector of Customs at Boston to use every endeavor to ascertain the parties who shipped the infernal machines from that city that were recently received by steamer in England.
THE Treasury Department ordered the discontinuance of the manufacture and sale of gold tokens stamped "quarter dollar" and "half dollar." Persons manufacturing or selling such tokens are rendering themselves liable to penalties of both fine and imprisonment.
THE Chinese Ministers to this Government, Chin Lin Ping and Yung Wang, have been withdrawn by their Government. They will be succeeded by a single representative. This is in deference to the expression of other first-class Powers, which are recognized by only one Minister from China.
THE Postal Telegraph Company has been organized at New York, with a capital of \$20,000,000. James R. Keene is President. The company propose to enter the field as competitors of the Western Union, and say they will stretch their wires to every locality where the latter company has an office.

THE International Conference of Young Men's Christian Associations met in Exeter Hall, London, on the 29th ult. About 300 delegates were in attendance, some sixty being from the United States and the Dominion of Canada, and the remainder from Great Britain, France, Switzerland, Germany and other countries.
THE Washington correspondent of the New York Tribune says it is understood that since the shooting of the President at several members of the Cabinet have received threatening letters from persons who evidently imbued with the belief that the Government were then a living, and that where importunities have failed threats may succeed.
THE anti-Jewish crusade in Russia has led to the destruction of thirty houses inhabited by Jews in the village of Borpau and Birzian, in the government of Potavia. The troops fired upon the rioters, killing four.

ANOTHER duel has been fought at Berlin, in which the combatants were a student and an officer of the army reserve. Weapons, pistols. The student was killed. This is the fifth fatal duel of a similar character in Germany within a fortnight.

REV. WILLIAM F. WHITAKER, pastor of the Matheron Street Methodist Church in Providence, R. I., the most fashionable church of that denomination in the city, has been detected in purloining valuable old books from various parties and has resigned his charge and announced his intention of severing his connection with the ministry. Whitaker is 55 years of age, his father is wealthy and his wife has an independent income, while his own salary was \$2,000 a year. He generally mutilated the stolen books in such a way as to destroy their identity and then sold them, although many were still found in his possession.
THE marriage is announced of T. H. Tibbles, the advocate of the Ponca, and "Bright Eyes," said to be "the handsomest and best educated Indian woman in America."
JOHN J. JENNINGS was taken from jail at Tierra Amable, N. M., and hanged by a mob. He was charged with the murder of one Lewis and Lewis' wife, who is suspected of a criminal intimacy with her husband's murderer, is held for complicity in the crime. Three fatherless children are left without a home.
THOMAS M. MATFIELD, who killed his father-in-law, Marshall Adley, in Strafford Miss., in July, and then fled, has been arrested at Little Rock, Ark., and taken home for trial. Matfield admits the killing, but asserts that it was done in a rough and tumble fight, in which Adley was the aggressor.
MISS MINNIE REEVE, station agent and operator at Minnesota, Minn., was killed by a railway collision near that place on the 20th. She was a most estimable young lady, and was a sister of the Master Mechanic on the Iron Mountain Railroad.
NINE persons recently made their escape from the Yell County Jail at Danville, Ark. Two only had been recaptured at last accounts.
A TELEGRAM from Tunis says 1,500 Arabs have advanced to Padusa, six killed from Goletha. Four Europeans and three Arabs have been murdered. There is great excitement. The Bey has ordered the removal of the bridge of boats between Goletha and Padusa.
BLANCO FLORES, the Mexican murderer, and ex-member of the Vasquez gang of bandits, was recently killed near Yuma, Cal., while attempting to escape from custody.
The death is announced of ex-Governor Bagley, of Michigan. The deceased was visiting California for the benefit of his health. He was forty-nine years of age.
The hunt for the Williams brothers, who killed the Coleman brothers, Deputy Sheriffs of Dunn County, Wis., on the 10th of July, still continues. The murderers are known as desperate men, well armed and supplied with ammunition, and thoroughly familiar with every nook and corner of the wilderness lying between the Wisconsin and the Michigan boundaries.
COL. E. FRIE, a member of the National Council of the Republic in Washington, has been elected to represent that Republic in Washington.
A CABLE dispatch from Glasgow, Scotland, reports the arrival there, in good condition, of a consignment of Minnesota wheat which had been shipped by the large liner from New Orleans and thence by steamer.
AT Ash Grove, Troup County, Ill., John Snaggy, aged 15 years, accidentally killed his brother William, aged 17, with a hot-iron while shooting at a target. In Kaskaskia Township, Poria County, Minn., Walter, aged 10, was accidentally shot and killed by his 19-year-old brother while he was carelessly handling a revolver.

MISSOURI STATE NEWS.

THE dwelling of M. Silverstone, at Calais, Me., was damaged by fire on the 29th. George Bradford was killed, and four others were wounded by falling chimneys.
At Leadville, Colo., on the 29th, Frank Gilbert and Merrick Rosengrant were executed for murder, the latter protesting his innocence. Isiah Walker, colored, was hanged at Gonzales, Texas, for murdering his wife some months ago.
A DOUBLE tragedy was recently enacted near Stoneville in the Cherokee Nation. Major A. Williams, becoming frenzied through jealousy of his wife, shot her through the head, causing instant death. He then blew out his own brains. The dead bodies were found lying only a few feet apart.
WILLIAM A. STEWART, County Clerk of San Francisco, Cal., has shipped out leaving a shortage in his accounts of \$60,000. Stock speculators and fast horses did it.
The steamers Idlewild and Osceola blew up at the Memphis wharf on the night of the 31st. The fire originated in the lamp-burner of the Idlewild, and spread so rapidly that the entire boat was enveloped in flames. The Osceola blew up just above the Idlewild, and before it could be got to her assistance she took fire and floated down the river a burning mass. James Lee, lying just below the Idlewild, ran a very narrow escape from destruction, but was badly damaged. The Idlewild and the flames extinguished. The Idlewild had just been thoroughly repaired and was loading for her last trip between Memphis and Arkansas City. She was owned by Capt. John D. Adams, of Little Rock, and Capt. James H. Reese, of Pittsburg, and valued at about \$2,000. Insurance \$10,000. The Osceola blew up between Memphis and Osceola. She belonged to the Lee Line, was valued at \$20,000, with no insurance. A small quantity of freight was destroyed.
A TERRIBLE accident occurred at Peoria, Ill., on the night of the 29th. By the explosion of an overcharged still at the Wagon Brewery, eighteen persons were injured, several of them fatally. The names of the killed and those who died soon afterward from their injuries are as follows: Lemuel Woolner, one of the proprietors, and Max Woolner, son of another proprietor; two sons of Wm. Voell (the father probably fatally injured); Henry Casing, engineer; Henry Goetz, Charles Henninger and August Briet, employees; John Kuhlman, a visiting brewer from Brooklyn, N. Y.; August Heiler and Wm. Eise, two other employees, are supposed to be fatally injured.
JOHN MURRAY and his aged mother, who resided near Havana, Ill., were driving home from town in a wagon containing a quantity of straw, when it is supposed the old lady dropped some fire from her pipe, which set the straw ablaze. She was burned to death.
Five incendiary fires at Lena, Mich., within a few weeks have destroyed much valuable property and greatly exasperated the citizens. On the 20th, the incendiary got in his work again by firing the Congregational Church, which was totally destroyed.
The wife, daughter, and infant child of John Snyder, a planter living in Lee County, Ark., were drowned while crossing a layover on a flat-bottom in Prairie County. They were seated in a wagon and the horses became restive and backed it off the bank.
The entire business portion of White Hall, Muskegon County, Mich., was destroyed by fire on the night of the 29th. Loss about \$150,000.
KENT MCNITT, Deputy Secretary of State of Tennessee, was accidentally drowned at Nashville on the 31st.
LATE NEWS ITEMS.
The President's doctors have at last located the bullet in the front wall of the abdomen, immediately over the groin, at a depth of five inches below and to the right of the navel. Dr. Haudfield thinks the patient will be able to resume "a certain class of official duties" by the middle of August.
A WASHINGTON dispatch of the 1st says Assistant Secretary of the Treasury Upton has returned to his desk in the Department. He will not, it is now understood, be removed from his place nor will Mr. Lamphere.
A violent explosion, with great loss of life, is reported from Mazatlan, Mexico. The building was situated in the center of the business portion of the town. The explosion completely razed the magazine and destroyed many houses in the immediate vicinity, besides doing considerable damage to a number of others and killing the number of people, including a large number of soldiers and citizens, went to work to recover the bodies of those known to be buried in the ruins. Several bodies were recovered, and among them was Francisco Pena, District Judge. The number of killed and wounded is not yet known, as many bodies are said to be still buried under the ruins.
The Emperor and Empress of Russia were enthusiastically received at Moscow. They went on foot from the Palace to the cathedral, and afterward had a reception at the Kremlin. A review of troops closed the festivities.
It is reported that there are good grounds for believing that the number of Mr. Pugh, of Cincinnati, was done in Mexico by a band of Mexicans, and not Indians, as it is reported and he would. Secretary Kirkwood has expressed the belief that the report is a confession of the fact that the murderers will be brought to justice.
A COLLISION between freight trains on the Pennsylvania Railroad, near Lancaster, Pa., resulted in wrecking two locomotives, eight cars and a caboose. Engineer James Hanckey probably fatally wounded. A storm was raging at the time, and the fireman says he could not see a car's length ahead.
The Emperor of Germany has conferred upon Prof. Wm. Dwight Whitney, of Massachusetts, the order of merit made vacant by the death of Thomas Child.
At Detroit, Mich., Mrs. John Simpson, a boarding-house keeper, while returning from market, the other night, was shot by a man concealed behind a fence, who immediately ran away. Her husband, from whom she has been separated some time, and between whom and her frequent quarrels have occurred, was arrested on suspicion. Mrs. Simpson died charging her husband with committing the deed.
