NORTHERN SOLDIERS NOW AT SHANGHAI

Four Thousand Men Landed and It is Expected They Will March to Arsenal.

SHANGHAI, July 30.—Northern army reinforcements, estimated to number 4,000, with two cruisers, arrived in the Yang Tse river Tuesday. The troops were loaded 20 miles below Wu Sung, apparently with a view to marching to the arsenal here.

Practically all the civilians have left Wu Sung for Shanghai, expecting a bombardment, which up to this time, has been explicitly delayed. Shanghai thus is exposed to an influx of refugees from the south and north. Considerable damage has been done to the native city by fire, which was partly due to bursting shells and partly to incendiaries with a view to looting which has been extensive. The foreign settlements, however, have been comparatively free from this evil.

A serious prospect is a shortage of food, due to the holding up of the small native coasting ships from Che Kiang ports.

GEN. W. H. BIXBY WILL RETIRE FROM ARMY

Will Give Col. W. T. Rossell a Chance to Become Chief of the Engineers.

WASHINGTON, July 30.—At his own request, Gen. William H. Bixby, chief of engineers of the United States army, will retire Aug. 11 in favor of Col. William T. Rossell, the senior colonel of the engineer corps. Gen. Bixby would not leave the active service on account of age until next December, two months after the date upon which Col. Rossell must retire. Hence, he asked for retirement before that date in order that his brother officer might reach the highest place in the engineer corps.

STRIKE MAY TIE UP BUSINESS IN CHICAGO

Claimed That 700 Train Employees Will be Called Out Unless Demands are Met.

CHICAGO, July 30.—Officials of the Locomotive Engineers and Switchmen's organization have threatened to call out 700 men employed by the Belt Railway of Chicago and the Chicago and Western Indiana Wednesday if the roads do not meet their demands for shorter hours and a wage increase.

Several conferences have been held between the union representatives and the officials of the railroads. The men were in conference Tuesday. The railroad officials when seen Tuesday denied that they had been advised that a strike had been ordered.

VOTING MACHINES ARE PLACED ABOUT THE CITY

Voters Will Get a Chance to Learn the Working Before Primary is Held.

In order that voters may become familiar with the workings of voting machines City Clerk Bilinski has caused six of them to be placed in various localities about the city. Men have been placed in charge of the machines and will instruct those desiring information regarding their operation.

The machines have been placed as follows: One at the city hall, another at the court house, a third at the Mohr barber shop, corner of Cushing st. and Michigan av.; a fourth at the Cimmerman drug store, corner of Rex st. and Portage av.; a fifth at the Gross and Gross department store, Catalpa av., and the sixth at the Kolupa drug store, 407 Chapin st. Two additional machines will be placed in the second and sixth wards, and all will be kept in operation until a few days before the fall election.

FOURTEEN BOYS TAKE HIKE TO BARRON LAKE

Lads From Trinity Presbyterian Church Prepared for a Ten Days' Stay in Camp.

Equipped with a supply of clothes, bedding and cooking utensils, 14 boy members of the Trinity Presbyterian church and also of the National Boy Scouts' association, started from South Bend at 9 o'clock Tuesday morning on a hike near Barron lake, near Niles. They were accompanied by Rev. John S. Burns and Leslie G. Whitcomb, assistant pastor of Trinity Presbyterian church.

The boys are planning to remain at the lake ten days during which time they will be instructed in the rudiments of woodcraft and camp life. Spiritual services will be held each day at the camp and on Sunday the boys will attend church at Niles.

HOTTEST WEATHER OF SUMMER HITS CHICAGO

Temperature Reaches the 99 Mark But Few Prostrations are Reported.

CHICAGO, July 30.—The hottest weather of this summer visited Chicago Tuesday. On top of the federal building where the weather bureau is located, in the coolest spot in the downtown district, the temperature was 99 degrees, but in other sections it was three or four degrees hotter. The heat wave, however, was relieved by brisk winds and there was not the toll of deaths and prostrations which was caused by the hot spell of ten days in the early part of the summer. Only a few prostrations were reported. The forecast was for continued warm weather.
