THREE TIGER PITCHERS WIN MORE THAN SQUAD

Donovan, Killian and Mullin Flung More Victories in 1907 Than Whole 1913 Staff.

DETROIT, Mich., Nov. 3.—Three pitchers, Donovan, Killian and Mullin, won more games for the Tigers the first time they captured the American league pennant (in 1907) than all of the Jungle hurlers put together were able to take during the season of 1913.

In each of several years three twirlers carted off 70 games for the year's work, while the entire Tiger crew could garner only 66 this year.

As a matter of fact in 1907 Donovan and Killian together came within 16 games of the mark 1913, winning 25 each. They could add to theirs either the winning games of Mullin, who won 20, or of Siever, who won 19, and beat the 1913 Tiger's mark.

In 1908, the only year not mentioned in which the Tigers copped the flag, three pitchers came within nine of the 66 mark, and four of them passed it by the length of a dashund.

Here's another fact, that is startling. In 1907, Donovan, Siever and Mullin pitched the Tigers within one of the number of victories gained by Washington this past season. Washington is second in the standing and pressed the Athletics for the lead of

MODERATE TEMPERATURE PROMISED FOR WEEK

WASHINGTON, Nov. 3.—Clear skies and moderate temperatures are promised by the weather bureau for practically the entire country for the next few days.

"With the exception of a little rain and snow early in the week over the extreme northwest," said the weekly bulletin Sunday night, "generally fair weather will prevail over the country until the middle of the week, when another disturbance will appear over the far northwest, bringing with it some rain and snow that will probably extend eastward over the upper Mississippi valleys and the greater portion of the lake region by the end of the week."

"In the Ohio valley and the southwest fair weather will continue after the middle of the week. Temperatures will arise early in the week over the central and the interior eastern portions of the country and will fall somewhat in the middle plateau, but no unusual extremes of temperature are indicated at present for any portion of the country."
