Although defeated by Goshen and Benton Harbor, Elkhart came back strong and defeated the Winona "Aggies" last Saturday by a score of seven to six.



EIGHT MANAGERS WANT GOV. TENER TO LEAD LEAGUE

Only Few Minor Details to be Settled Before New Leader is Picked—All Settled Says Ebbets.

HARRISBURG, Pa., Nov. 20.—Gov. Tener said Wednesday night that only a few minor details were to be arranged before his acceptance of the presidency of the National league of baseball clubs.

The governor was tendered the presidency of the league being assured of the votes of all clubs by H. W. Hempstead, representing the New York club; Harry Ackerland, representing Chicago; Chas. E. Ebbets, representing Brooklyn; and W. F. Baker, representing Philadelphia.

On the way to the train the governor said: "We had hoped the matter would be settled, but some minor points in the negotiations remain to be considered and the representatives here will consult with their colleagues who are not present."

The governor then continued, "In case I accept the presidency of the National league I will not resign as governor. Neither will I give my undivided time to the affairs of the league for the balance of my term as governor."

It was understood that the governor desired to have some further communication from the club owners not here, but from all accounts all have declared that they desire him and the representatives here said they considered it as closed.
