NEW YORK, Dec. 2.—As a result of evidence given at the John Doe inquiry that barefaced bribery was used to mulct the contractors of New York state, Dist. Atty. Whitman Tuesday set out to prove that the lines of graft extended to the biggest politicians of the state and were pulled by them. There is doubt that more indictments are to be returned and attaches for the district attorney declare "that bigger fish" than those already landed will be caught before the investigation is ended.
Mr. Whitman confirmed dispatches from Harrisburg, Pa., stating that ex-Cong. Roland B. Mahony of Buffalo, who is under arrest there on a charge of attempted suicide, is to be called. Mahony tried to end his life with poison and by cutting his throat.
Whitman said that he would like to quiz the ex-congressman as to his relations with Henry P. Burgard of Buffalo and George C. Deihl, former member of the highway advisory board.
