



HERZOG SELECTED TO MANAGE REDS IN PENNANT RACE

Outlines Views of Building Up a Winner Before Signing Contract—Expects to Depend on Team's Speed.

CINCINNATI, Dec. 19.—Charles Herzog, former ball player with the New York and Boston National league clubs, was chosen Thursday as manager of the Cincinnati team for the season of 1914. After a conference with the board of directors and a second conference with Pres. August Herrmann and Secy. Harry Stephens, Herzog signed a contract as a player for a year and was then officially made manager.

Herzog steps into the position made vacant by the sale of former Manager Joe Tinker to the Brooklyn club. He will play at shortstop as did Tinker, and guide the team on the field. Herzog outlined his ideas of a winning team to the board of directors and they were approved.

Herzog said he believed in a fast, dashing team, much on the order of the New York National league team of which he was a member before coming to Cincinnati, but he added he had no trades or sales in mind at present.

Herzog is 28, and was born in Baltimore. He is a graduate of Maryland university and after a short minor league experience, was signed by Manager McGraw of the New York team with which he played in 1908 and 1909. He was traded to the Boston National league team and played with that club through the season of 1910 and about half of the season of 1911 when he was brought back to New York by a deal made for him by McGraw.

The New York leader recently made a trade for him with Cincinnati, in which the New York club gave Herzog and Catcher Hartley for Outfielder Bob Bescher.

AINSWORTH IS ABOUT READY TO QUIT GAME

Youngstown Lad Who Finished With Fort Wayne Disgusted Over Failure Last Year.

YOUNGSTOWN, O., Dec. 19.—Claude Varnell, owner of the Fort Wayne club in the Central league, stands an excellent chance of being without one of his fingers when the 1914 training season opens next spring. The heavier in question is none other than Earl Ainsworth, for three seasons a Youngstown favorite where he learned the professional brand of twirling. Ainsworth in a letter to a local friend several days ago said he had about decided to quit baseball as he had lost all hope of ever reaching the majors.

This is not unlike the stand taken by Auburn haired chap here last spring before the Interstate season began. Thoroughly disgusted at his inability to make good with the Boston Red Sox, with whom he went to training camp, Ainsworth said he would give the professional game just one more season of this time. When the interstate league took the punch, "Red" was sold to Fort Wayne. He got away bad in the Billiken city and it is not likely he will report to Varnell in the spring.
