

CITIZENS PARTY WINS HANDILY IN LAKEVILLE

Charles Bailey and Gabriel Motts Elected to Town Board.

LAKEVILLE, Ind., Nov. 3.—Citizens' party candidates won a complete victory in the town election held here Tuesday. Charles Bailey and Gabriel Motts, citizens' party candidates for the town board, received 54 and 52 votes respectively, while Charles Smith and James Annla, people's party nominees, received 20 and 27.

Charles Oberly, who had no opposition for the office of treasurer, received 50 votes. Russell Borts, citizens' candidate for town clerk, received 57 votes, and Robert Acler, people's nominee, polled 44. Nate Lyons, citizens' nominee, was elected marshal over Frank T. Barkley, the vote being 44 and 37.

REPUBLICANS WIN.

WALKERTON, Ind., Nov. 3.—The republican party ticket, with one exception, was elected in the town election held here Tuesday.

O. C. Schockner, democratic nominee for town trustee, was the only one on his ticket to be elected. The complete returns follow: For township trustee—M. D. BERLIN CLAIMS RUSS THROWN BACK AGAIN

General Engagement Expected Soon Along Railway Leading to Riga.

LONDON, Nov. 3.—A fresh German advance on Riga from the west and the Russian drive toward the city before Dvinsk are claimed by Berlin Tuesday night.

The Germans, striking along the Tekkum-Riga railway and to the south along the river banks have brought their advance to a point where a general engagement is soon expected.

Meanwhile the Russians, furiously counter-attacking in the Dvinsk region, have held large Russian forces in check. The Russian losses are said to be heavy.

While the fighting in the north is of the most desperate character, engagements scarcely less intense have been fought in the region of Sienikowice, where the czar's troops succeeded in penetrating the lines of the Gen. von Rothner's army.

Berlin tonight claims that the Austro-Germans here have regained all of their lost trenches and have taken 600 Russian prisoners.

The greater part of the village of Sienikowice is said to have been recaptured.

TWO SONS OF HENRY TEMPLE ARE MISSING

Henry and Paul Play Truant From Oliver School and Fall to Come Home.

Henry Temple, 1719 S. Taylor st., notified the police department Tuesday night to look out for his two small sons, Henry and Paul, who have been missing since 4 o'clock Tuesday afternoon.

The two boys played truant from the Oliver school in the afternoon and failed to come home at night.

Paul, 11 years old, wore a striped waist and grey trousers, and Henry, seven years old, wore a grey overcoat and grey trousers. They were last seen near the Union Dental parlors, about 4 o'clock in the afternoon.

JOHN D. LOSES FIGHT

Brother's Candidate, J. J. Sinnott, is Elected.

TARRYTOWN, N. Y., Nov. 3.—John D. Rockefeller lost out in his political fight here Tuesday against his brother, William. John J. Sinnott, democratic nominee, who was backed by the brother, won out over Seabury C. Mastick, republican, who was supported by "John D." by more than 200 votes.

Walter W. Law, Jr., assemblyman who was opposed by the Rockefeller's and the wealthy residents along Broadway, was elected by 1,850. But he lost Rockefeller's town by 150.

GARY RAIL HEAD DIES

John Kirk One of Best Known Executives in Country.

GARY, Ind., Nov. 3.—John Kirk, 57 years old, president of the Gary board of education, and one of the best known railway executives in the country, died Tuesday. As superintendent of the Gary and South Chicago division of the Elgin, Joliet and Eastern railroad, a steel corporation line, Mr. Kirk directed all transportation incidental to the building of the city of Gary and the steel mills here. The Kirk railway yards, the largest in the west, were named after him. Supt. Kirk is survived by a widow and three children.

INVALID DOCTOR KILLED

Alexander C. Freeman Eludes Wife and is Hit by Train.

KOKOMO, Nov. 3.—Dr. Alexander C. Freeman, 81, formerly a prominent practitioner but recently frail of mind and limb, is dead here, having been run down and killed by a passenger train.

Freeman evaded the vigilance of his wife, under whose care he had been an invalid, and started down the railroad tracks, unmindful of an approaching train. Mrs. Freeman pursued him and was attempting to drag him from the tracks when the engine struck him.
