

### TO START WORK ON INDUSTRIAL RE-CONSTRUCTION

#### May Give Labor New Status in the Industrial World.

WASHINGTON, May 13.—Work on a program of industrial re-construction in which labor will receive greater recognition starts in congress Friday.  
The senate education and labor committee then begins hearings with the aim of drafting a legislative program to give labor a new status in the industrial world. Herbert Hoover will be the first witness to be called because of his long experience as an employer and his experience as a member of the president's second industrial conference. Later Samuel Gompers and labor leaders will be heard and then ex-Prest' Taft and Charles M. Schwab. Time To Act.  
"It is time we were doing some-

thing for labor," Chairman Kenyon said today. "We are looking out for the railroads, for shipping interests, for the dye manufacturers and for everybody but the man who can least look out for himself."  
"The committee begins its hearings with no pre-conceived ideas because it wants to get the frank and unbiased views of employers, labor and the public so that a program for the best interests of all can be framed."

#### DEBS SELECTED TO RUN FOR PRESIDENCY

NEW YORK, May 13.—Eugene V. Debs, who is serving sentence for violation of the espionage act in the Atlanta penitentiary, was today nominated as the presidential candidate of the socialist party. The vote of the convention was unanimous.  
Edward Henry, of Indianapolis made the nomination speech, and seconding speeches were made by John Block of New York, James O'Neal of New York and Irvin St. John Tucker of Illinois.  
The caucus of nominating committeemen has decided upon Seymour Steedman of Chicago as the vice presidential nominee. Other nominations were expected but, it was said, Steedman would be chosen by a large majority.
