

### CHARGES PLOT TO REGULATE PRICES

#### Lesh Declares Ice Dealers' Association Controls Rates in State.

INDIANAPOLIS, June 23.—Suit to break up Indiana's alleged statewide ice trust was filed against 15

Indiana ice companies and individuals by Atty. Gen. U. S. Lesh in the Marion county superior court today. Stanley Wyckoff is named defendant both as an individual and as secretary of the Indiana Ice Dealers' association. The court is asked to put the companies out of business.

The attorney general charges that the ice manufacturers conspired to form a trust with the object of monopolizing trade, limiting manufacture of ice, controlling prices, and destroying competition.

The complaint avers that the manufacturers paved the way

for ice famine by failure to accumulate a surplus during cool weather and that they regulated the quantity of their output so as to "sell for a high and exorbitant price."

**Prevent Free Trade.**

The price, 50 cents per hundred pounds in Indianapolis, is much higher than if free competition were permitted, the complaint sets out.

That the ramifications of the "trust" are state-wide is the charge of the attorney general, who asserts in his bill that prices fixed in Indianapolis are communicated by

Wyckoff to dealers throughout the state who are members of the retailers' body. Through their system of controlling the retailers, the manufacturers affectually prevent the peddling of ice not made by the "trust" according to Mr. Lesh's complaint.

The attorney general asks that the alleged monopoly be adjudged a combination in restraint of trade and that the court dissolve the trust, forfeit the licenses and charters of the defendants and wind up their corporate affairs through receiverships.

The complaint is an aftermath of an investigation of the ice industry by the attorney general and the Indianapolis Housewives' League.

Mrs. Marchese ran to the side walk and found her husband dead, with the death car speeding away. She dropped to her knees, hugged and kissed the victim. An undertaker found that 17 slugs entered Marchese's body. Mrs. Marchese denied her husband had received threatening letters.
