N. D. Student Now With Father at Irish Conclave

Albert Castellini, Cincinnati, Young Man, Attending Convention in Paris.

The world-wide convention of the Irish race, now in session in Paris, is arousing added interest in this city and particularly at Notre Dame university, because of the presence at the congress of Albert Castellini, well known Notre Dame student, and his father, Joseph J. Castellini of Cincinnati.

Mr. Castellini has been chosen a member of the committee, which is headed by De Valera, and representing the United States at the conclave.

Before returning to this country, however, an extended tour of Europe is planned, including a visit to the Vatican in Rome.

During his two years at Notre Dame, "Al" has been prominently identified with student activities and also the Irish cause.

LANE SCHEDULES DAYS FOR REPORTS

Convicted Liquor Law Violators, on Probation, Must Report Monthly.

Confronted with the prospect of a decided increase in the number of defendants on probation by the city court due to City Judge DuComb's announced intention of keeping a watchful eye on moonshiners and bootleggers, Probation Officer Luther Lane issued an announcement Wednesday that all such defendants placed in his charge will be ordered to make reports to him regularly each month.

To further facilitate his handling of such cases, the first Wednesday and first Saturday of each month are set as the time when liquor law violators on probation will be required to make regular monthly calls concerning their conduct.

This arrangement, according to the newly appointed probation officer, will permit him to carry on his usual work of investigation, self-augmented by the court's practice of putting liquor law offenders on probation.

Since his appointment little more than a week ago, Lane has received

20 new cases handed him for investigation and where defendants have been placed in his charge for a definite period of time. In addition to these, five or six were left over to his care by his predecessor, the present Chief of Police Lawrence J. Lane.

So far, the probation officer has been requested by the court to take charge of eight liquor law defendants upon whom sentences have been suspended and three drunks. Reputations of offenses are to be reported to Judge DuComb and such sentences then revoked. At present, Lane has 12 domestic relationship cases where defendants are charged with non-support, lazy husband and kindred offenses.
