

### Lakeville Teamsters Reap Cash Harpest on Own Impassable St.

Lakeville, ten miles out of South Bend, did a most flourishing business on Saturday and Sunday in the matter of rescuing automobiles from its own impassable streets.

The little incorporated town has one stretch of street, and only one, between the railroads that hedge in the village.

Coming into the town from the south, the autoist is blocked by mud so deep that it means wreckage to a large machine to attempt to go through on its own power. The mud extends to the railroad at the southern boundary.

Six men with teams were busy all day Saturday and Sunday pulling autos through town. They extracted a fee of from \$2 up from all customers.

"Line up and take your turn" was the welcome of Lakeville's enterprising teamsters. At one time Sunday, there were 23 autos in line. Finally two of Henry's make

made the dash for it and got through.

"Better get a spade and dig those holes a little deeper" was the call of one of the team owners to another. No more flivvers made the trip. They paid with their more stately brethren.

Incensed at what he called the outrage, a prominent South Bend merchant drove his Studebaker through the morass. He got within ten feet before he was stalled by mud that went over the hub caps. He paid just as much as if he had let the teams pull him the entire distance.

The scene was so unusual that numbers of South Bend autoists made the trip Sunday for the purpose of watching the proceedings.

One of the six Lakeville residents engaged in teaming boasted at 3 o'clock that his earnings up to that time had been \$76 on the day.

### AVERAGE LOW IN TESTS ON CATTLE

Federal Veterinarian Finds Herds in Centre Twp. in Good Condition.

Dr. C. T. Howard, federal veterinarian, who has been testing cattle for tuberculosis in Center township, Monday made known the result of his Saturday's "readings."

Of the 361 cattle tested during the early part of the week, only 19 animals reacted. This average of 6.1 percent is considered very low and should be very gratifying news to farmers of St. Joseph county.

Some nearby counties have had an average as high as 16 percent.

It has been intimated that some farmers have not signed up to have their cattle tested because they feared they would lose too many members of their herds. It is believed that the low percentage shown in Center township will be a stimulus to farmers who have been a trifle backward for this reason.

Dr. Howard is now working northward on Michigan road and expects to complete his work in Center township this week.

German township will probably be the next tested as that township has the most persons with signatures on the accredited herd agreement blanks.

### Story Met Deaf Ears and Girls Forced to Jail

Two Gary Girls Spend Night in Jail Here While Awaiting \$1.

A one dollar prevented Florence and Ethel O'Neil, 18 and 17 years old, respectively, from making their way from South Bend to their home in Gary, where their father was anxiously awaiting them. His absence was the means which brought about their detention overnight in the county jail.

The story of what it is to be without funds and alone in a big city, is told afresh by the experiences of the two girls while here for a day, enroute to their home and folks. There were no sympathetic ears in which they could tell their story or a willing stranger who would open his purse and present them with a dollar.

Ethel came here to meet her older sister, but had been provided with just \$4.50 when she left her home in Gary. She met her sister but then had left but \$2.50 with which to purchase tickets for the two. The fare to Gary for a single ticket was \$1.75.
