For the information of hunters who are in the habit of going at will over farm lands without permission of the owners, we publish the following from the code of Iowa, 1897:

Section 2560. Hunting upon cultivated or enclosed land. No person shall hunt with dog or gun upon the cultivated or inclosed lands of another without first obtaining permission from the owner, occupant or agent thereof. Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be punished by a fine of not more than ten dollars and costs of prosecution, and shall stand committed until such fine and costs are paid, for each and every offense, but no prosecution shall be commenced under this section except upon the information of the owner, occupant or agent of such cultivated or inclosed lands.
