

Notice to Iowa Democrats.

Below we publish the constitution of the Iowa Democratic Club. We hope that you will read it carefully and then join the club. If not convenient to read the annual dues at this time send your name to the secretary and send the dollar to the treasurer later.

In addition to giving an annual banquet it is the purpose of the club to promote the interests of Democracy preparatory to the campaign of 1908.

The name of this organization shall be The Iowa Democratic Club; and its object shall be the promotion of the principles of the Democratic party.

The officers shall be a president, eleven vice presidents, a secretary, a treasurer, and an executive committee of eleven members.

A vice president shall be elected from each congressional district and the executive committee shall be appointed by the president, the secretary, and the treasurer.

All officers shall serve for a term of one year, or until their successors are elected and qualify.

The work of organization shall be under the immediate supervision of the president and the secretary but all of the general plans of organization must be approved by the executive committee.

To insure the harmonious working of the club and the state central committee, said committee shall be invited from time to time to meet in conference with the officers of the club.

The club shall give a banquet in some city in the state, to be selected by the executive committee, on the second of April of each year, or on the day following, when the second falls on Sunday.

The banquets are not to be formal invitation affairs but are to be open to the Democracy of the state.

The president, the secretary and the treasurer shall have charge of the arrangements of the details of the banquet which shall include the selection of a toastmaster and the speakers.

It shall also be the duty of the secretary to send to the Democratic Press of the state for publication, notices giving full particulars of the banquet, the notices to be in the hands of the editor not later than the first of March preceding the banquet. Notices must also be sent to all of the vice presidents, members of the executive committee, to the state central committee, and to all of the Democratic county chairmen of the state, other notices may be sent at the discretion of the secretary.

The regular annual meeting of the club shall be held on the day of the banquet at such a place as the president may designate, but it must be, if possible, in the building in which the banquet is to be held. Special meetings may be called by the president, and shall be called when requested by a majority of the executive committee or by a majority of the vice presidents.

All Iowa Democrats are eligible to membership. Annual dues of one dollar shall be charged.

School Elections.

The school election blanks have been mailed to each sub-director in the county and the proper blanks to each township secretary, each secretary of rural independent districts and to boards of directors of independent city districts. Also circulars giving explicit directions and explanations of the new law have been sent to the proper authorities, so that no mistakes can be made if these are carefully read and directions followed. No change is made in the time of holding elections and city school boards organize on the third Monday in March as they have done heretofore, but rural independent districts and school townships do not organize till July 1st and directors elected in these districts may qualify any time before the close of that day (July 1st). No taxes are to be levied till July 1st that being the annual meeting which takes the place of Sept. and March meetings under the old law. If a tie vote should be the result in any district the judges of the election determine then and there by lot who is entitled to the office. Do not take another ballot. We hope those who are interested in the conduct of our schools will go to the election and vote. Some remain at home and then find fault with result of the election. If you are interested in any way, it is your privilege and duty as well, to cast your vote for what you think is right.
