We moved eleven miles northeast of El Reno last February on the farm we are living on now. We have a pleasant place to live and we think Oklahoma a nice place to live. We have two little girls aged two and four years. Before I close I must tell you a little about El Reno. I tell you we have a fine little city and it is on the boom. Property is increasing in value every day. They are building the Rock Island round house now and they are also building a large new pottery plant. If this escapes the waste basket I may write again and will ask you to please send our Reporter to Okarche, Okla., R. F. D. No. 4 instead of El Reno. We could not get along without our Reporter.

### Nail In Her Hand Over a Year.

In handling an old barrel-stave over thirteen months ago, Mrs. W. E. Massey, 21 miles northwest of town, pierced one of her thumbs with a small nail, the nail entering the flesh above the first joint on the inside of the thumb. The wound was a very painful one and a physician was called upon to treat it. He did not discover that the nail was still in the wound, and since that time the hand has been almost useless to Mrs. Massey, the place repeatedly inflaming and gathering and requiring repeated lancing. A few weeks ago a gathering appeared above the original wound, in the muscles between the base of the thumb and the knuckle joint of the fore finger. This in turn was lanced by a physician and on Monday of last week in dressing the wound Mrs. Massey saw the end of a nail protruding from it and succeeded in pulling it out. It was  $\frac{1}{2}$  of an inch in length, the head broken off and jointed at one end. It was nearly two inches from the point where it entered her thumb. The wound and presence of the nail in the flesh has given the lady untold suffering and she is to be congratulated on the fortunate termination of the trouble after so long a time. —Lineville Tribune.
