

Contract Let for Repairs to Cainsville Dam.

T. W. Hall, of the Cainsville Milling Co., went to Des Moines Thursday of last week to consult a firm of contractors about the matter of repairing the damage done the dam by the recent raise of the river. He consulted the noted firm of Barney, Marsh & Co., whose operations extend all over the country in the erection of bridges and concrete work.

A representative of the company came down Saturday, looked over the situation at the dam and made a proposition for its repair. A price was agreed upon and he announced before leaving that the work would be commenced at once and the material is expected to arrive this week. Actual work will begin as soon as the material arrives, certainly not later than sometime next week.

Under the terms of the contract a concrete flume will be built extending about 100 feet long from the west end of the way containing the water gate to the high bank. Here a long wing will be built into the high bank as high as high water mark. This, it is believed, will prevent washing or cutting by high waters in the future. The river has cut a wide channel around the north end of the dam and the repairs will cost as much if not more than the original work of putting in the dam.

When this is completed the Milling Company will yet have to put in the fore-bay which will be a large undertaking and it is not likely that the mill will be in actual operation for several months yet. The company has suffered a severe stroke of misfortune but when the plant is finally completed they will have one of the best milling plants in north Missouri. Cainsville sincerely trusts they will have no further trouble. —Cainsville News.
