EL PASO, Texas, Oct. 11.—Although Villistas are reported to be occupying Madera, where big foreign owned lumber mills valued at millions of dollars are located, and to be operating five trains on the Mexican Northwestern, Mexican defacto troops have not yet set out in pursuit of the bandits, according to reports made to United States government agents here. Many Carranza troops are being massed at the Chihuahua capital, but none sent out to round up Villistas. The mills were not harmed, it was said.
