CUT OFF FINGER TO ESCAPE DRAFT

Lindsay M. Carr's Claim for Industrial Compensation is Refused in Hearing Before Board.

HE ASKED EXEMPTION

He is Said to Have Threatened to Cut Off Finger, But Even This Failed to "Keep Him Out of War."

A case with all the action and thrilling situations of a moving picture scenario was tried before Deputy Industrial Commissioner Ralph Young of Des Moines, with W. G. Blood and John M. Rankin sitting with him as arbitrators, being the case of Lindsay M. Carr against the Du Pont Powder company, in which Carr claimed damages for the loss of a portion of the index finger of his right hand.

The powder company admitted the fact of the injury, but denied that the claimant was acting within the scope of his employment at the time that it occurred, and as an affirmative defense claimed that the injury was wilfully and intentionally inflicted upon himself for the purpose of escaping United States army service.

Not content with having secured his classification, the testimony disclosed that he proceeded to talk among the neighbors about having put one over on the exemption board. This talk was reported to the exemption board, and after a personal examination by Chairman Scott it was disclosed that, instead of supporting the family, claimant was being supported by his father.

He then declared to witnesses that he would go to work at the powder works and cut off his finger before he went to war. A former sweetheart, with whom he had kept company for more than a year, and to whom he was engaged at the time, testified that he told her that he would cut off his finger before he would go to war, and that within a very short time the finger was cut off.

Gets Overseas in Hurry. After this injury the claimant again applied for deferred classification, but the circumstances of the case were detailed to the adjutant general, who instructed the local board to send him on with the next contingent, which was done, and whether by accident or intention, the claimant was promptly landed with the army in France. It may be said to his credit that at the end of his service he was given an honorable discharge as a first class private.

BURIED IN BIG TRENCH

Laborer in Fort Madison Caught by Cave-in and is Smothered to Death Before Rescue is Made.

FORT MADISON, Dec. 17.—Buried beneath several tons of earth and rock, the life of Joseph Havedick, aged 45 years, 1733 Des Moines street, was snuffed out by suffocation yesterday afternoon. The accident occurred in the sewer excavations being made by the National Construction company near the plant of the Perfection Tire and Rubber company.

The walls of the ditch in which Havedick was working gave way about 1:30 o'clock, burying the man. Employees and citizens rushed to the aid of the man and dug feverishly until nearly 3:30 o'clock before they uncovered his head. Life was extinct by that time.
