On motion the Board of Supervisors ex officio Board of Canvassers proceeded to check over and sign the certificates of the vote cast at the Primary Election June 5th, 1916.

On motion the County Treasurer was ordered to transfer the sum of fourteen hundred and no-100 dollars (\$1400.00) from the Poll Fund and the sum of One Thousand and no-100 (\$1000.00) from the Domestic Animal Fund to the County Fund.

On motion the Board adjourned to meet again July 3rd, 1916.
