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**OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS**

**Of the Board of Supervisors of Howard County.**

The Board of Supervisors of Howard County, Iowa, met in regular adjourned session in the office of the County Auditor at Cresco, Iowa, Tuesday, December 16, 1913, with Supervisors Chas. H. Wallace, J. F. Pecinovsky and J. W. Conway and E. A. Hoopman, County Auditor and Clerk of the Board present. The meeting was called to order by Chas. H. Wallace, chairman of the Board.

Petition of Isaac Wagner. To the Honorable Board of Supervisors of Howard County, Iowa: Comes now Isaac Wagner and being duly sworn says:

That he is the present owner in fee simple of the South East quarter of the South East quarter of Section Thirty-five (35) Township Ninety-nine (99) North of Range Fourteen (14) West of the Fifth (5th) P. M. That said premises were originally granted to Howard County by State of Iowa as claimed against said title due to swamp lands.

And whereas it appears that there are objections and clouds of the claimed defective conveyance of Howard County.

Petitioner asks that a quit claim deed be given from Howard County, Iowa, to Isaac Wagner, of said premises, and that the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors and Auditor of Howard County, Iowa, be authorized and empowered to deliver a quit claim deed of the said premises to petitioner. That petitioner is willing to pay all expenses therefor.

Be it resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Howard County, Iowa, in regular adjourned session this 16 day of December, 1913

That, whereas it is claimed that the conveyance executed by Howard County to the McGregor Western Railway Company of the South East quarter of Section Thirty-five (35) Township Ninety-nine (99) North of Range Fourteen (14) West of the Fifth (5th) P. M. is technically defective,

And Whereas, the petition of Isaac Wagner is on file showing that he is the present owner in fee simple of said premises

And Whereas, Howard County makes no claim to said premises,

Be it resolved, that said petition be granted, that the Chairman of this Board of Supervisors, and the Auditor of Howard County authorized and empowered to execute a quit claim deed to the said Isaac Wagner, the effects of which shall be to convey whatever interest Howard County might have in said premises to the said Isaac Wagner.

That a Quit Claim Deed was presented and signed as above required by the Chairman of the Board and the Auditor of Howard County and same is duly approved and delivered.

On motion said resolution was adopted.

Whereas, Thomas Dixon and wife, and Mrs. Short, all of Jamestown Township, have made application to the trustees of said township for said,

Therefore, be it resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Howard County, Iowa, that the Trustees of Jamestown Township be and are hereby authorized to issue orders to the amount of \$3.00 per week for the support of Thomas Dixon and wife to May first, 1914, and \$1.25 per week for the support of Mrs. Short to May first, 1914.

On motion said resolution was adopted.

On motion at 5 o'clock P. M. the Board adjourned to 8 o'clock A. M., Wednesday, December 17, 1913.

Second Day. The Board met pursuant to adjournment at 8 o'clock A. M., Wednesday, December 17, 1913, with all members present.

Whereas, W. L. Richards, County Engineer, estimated the bridge work done by N. M. Stark & Co. on contract at \$6499.00.

Therefore, be it resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Howard

County, Iowa, that the Auditor be and is hereby instructed to issue a warrant on the Bridge Fund to N. M. Stark & Co. for \$2553.40, being 85 per cent of the Engineer's estimate. On motion said resolution was adopted.

On motion the petition of R. P. Roberts for the cancellation of the 1912 tax on \$6,000.00 Moneys and Credits and the cancellation of the 1913 assessment of \$11,500.00 Moneys and Credits, Lime Springs Corporation was rejected.

On motion the bid of N. M. Stark & Co. to furnish two medium size car loads of 3x12x16 fir plank at \$28.75 per M. One car to be shipped to Cresco, Iowa, and one car to be shipped to Elma, Iowa, was accepted.

The balance of the day was occupied in examining claims against Howard County on file with the Auditor.

On motion the following claims were disposed of as follows and the Auditor was instructed to issue warrants on the proper funds in payment for claims allowed.
