OFFICIAL PUBLICATION OF THE MINUTES AND THE LIST OF CLAIMS.

**First Day.**

Aug. 9th, 1915.  
The Board of Supervisors of Howard County, Iowa, met pursuant to adjournment at 1 o'clock p. m., Monday, August 9th, 1915, with all members present.

The meeting was called to order by Chas. H. Wallace, Chairman of the Board.

On motion at 5 o'clock p. m., the Board adjourned to 8 o'clock a. m., Tuesday, August 10th, 1915.

**Second Day.**

The Board met pursuant to adjournment with all members present. On motion the Board ordered an Underwood typewriter for the Clerk's office.

On motion the road petition of C. D. Nichols et al through center of Sec. 33, Twp. 99 R. 11, was granted.

On motion the Auditor was instructed to issue warrants on the Poor Fund to Mrs. Anna Wittenbreer at the rate of \$1.50 per week for each of her three dependent children, to be paid every fourth week as ordered by Judge W. J. Springer.

On motion the petition of Jos. Shimek for a refund of 50 cents, one-half of the dog tax erroneously assessed to him and paid, was granted.

On motion the salary of the Deputy Sheriff was fixed at \$150.00 per year.

On motion the following resolution was adopted.

Be It Resolved, by the Board of Supervisors of Howard County, Iowa, that the Auditor be and is hereby instructed to issue warrants on the Bridge Fund to Chambers & Dobson for \$1981.21, the same being the final estimate on the 32' I beam bridge 20 rods east of the NW Corner Sec. 4-97-14, and 85 per cent of \$850.00 on the 32' I beam bridge 40 rods south of the NW. Corner Sec. 4-97-14 and 85 per cent of \$1090.00 on the 60' steel bridge 40 rods north of the SE. Corner Sec. 18-98-12.

On motion the bond of Fred Shields, Township Clerk of Howard Center Twp., appointed to fill vacancy, was approved.
