Proceeding of Board of Supervisors of Howard County.

Cresco, Iowa, December 20, 1915. The Board of Supervisors of Howard County, Iowa, met pursuant to adjournment, in the office of the County Auditor, at 1 o'clock p. m., Dec. 20, 1915.

The meeting was called to order by Chas. H. Wallace, Chairman, with the following members present, Chas. H. Wallace, Chairman, presiding, and Supervisors J. F. Pecinovskiy and J. W. Conway, all members being present.

On motion at 5 o'clock p. m., the Board adjourned to 8 o'clock a. m., Dec. 21, 1915.

Second Day.

The Board met pursuant to adjournment with all members present. The following resolution was presented and on motion adopted.

Be it Resolved, by the Board of Supervisors of Howard County, Iowa, that W. L. Richards be and is hereby appointed County Engineer for the year 1916 at a salary of \$100.00 per month and traveling expenses.

On motion the contract for the year 1916 between Howard County, by its Board of Supervisors, and W. L. Richards, County Engineer, was approved and the Chairman was instructed to sign said contract.

On motion the following resolution was adopted:

Be it Resolved, by the Board of Supervisors of Howard County, Iowa, that that part of Road No. 2 between Sections 25 and 26, Twp. 99, Range 11, be and is hereby vacated as petitioned for by C. F. Farnsworth et al, provided the costs are paid by petitioners by February 1st, 1916.

Whereas, on February 9th, 1915, the Board of Supervisors entered into a written contract with Chambers & Dobson, by the terms of which said Chambers & Dobson undertook and agreed to furnish all labor and material and construct a 45 foot steel bridge 75 rods east of the SW. corner Sec. 12-97-11, and a 24 foot slab bridge 70 rods north of the W 1/4 corner Sec. 2-97-11, and have said bridges completed on or before October 1st, 1915, and

Whereas, said contractors have not commenced work or furnished any material for said 24 foot slab bridge, now therefore,

Be it Resolved, by the Board of Supervisors of Howard County, Iowa, that said contractors are in default on said contract and have violated the same, and

Be it Further resolved, by said Board of Supervisors, that said contract be and the same hereby is cancelled and annulled.

The auditor is directed to notify said contractors by mail of this action.
