MR. CONWAY TO STATE ANTI-SALOON LEAGUE

Mr. P. V. D. Conway, representing Fredericksburg at the Anti-Saloon League in Richmond, argued that the negroes of that town are now more prosperous and contented, and that the progress of children in the schools shows the effect of the town having gone dry.

Mr. Conway at another time said that there was enough enthusiasm in this convention to "set on fire the State of Virginia," which was greeted with applause. Mr. Conway acknowledged that there was a possibility that the first test might show defeat, which was met by cries of "No! No!" "The possibility is that we may be beaten," he asserted again, "but it will be educational."

Mr. Conway told that in Fredericksburg they were beaten again and again; that sometimes the wets had more majority than the dries had voters. "But we went right at them again. We may be beaten in a State fight, but I hope we won't. The fruit is ripe. It is a crucial time. The tide will recede, and if we don't take advantage we may lose it altogether."

LEGISLATIVE

Senator Strode offered a bill which provides for the election of members of the State Corporation Commission by the voters of the State.

Senator Owen offered a bill to increase the members of the governor's staff from sixteen to twenty-five.

Senator Parsons offered a bill to abolish the school examiners. Senate and House Finance Committees will meet Thursday morning as the time for hearing the banking bill.

The House and Senate formally elected all the nominees of the caucus for judges and Butten for insurance commissioner.
