W. H. Anderson is developing water at his ranch four miles north of town. He dug a well fourteen years ago near his house, which has furnished him an abundant supply of water, and during the present long drought the supply has not diminished in the least. Four weeks ago he began sinking the well deeper, and at the depth of seventy feet, when drifts were run east and west, the flow of water has been increased from 5,000 gallons to 25,000 gallons daily. The water will be turned in the town reservoir for the use of the town and the Arizona Lumber & Timber Company.
