AN OPEN LETTER WHICH IS NOT OPEN TO MISUNDERSTANDING.
The following open letter to Dr. T. S. Verdi was furnished to the press by Mr. George H. Harries:
SIR: There appeared in the columns of the New York Tribune yesterday a statement and by receipt of a statement in which I am personally interested.
