GORMAN'S STIRRING SPEECH Democratic Position Outlined by the Leader of the Majority. His Party Must Stand Firm—Republican Taunts Will Avail Nothing—No Favoritism to Trusts or Class Interests—Bright Future of the Democracy.

Senator Gorman's speech was the feature of the morning session of the Senate. Mr. Gorman's speech was heard with interest by the opposition with the joint authorship of the "compromise" amendments which consolidated the Democratic side, and Mr. Gorman especially has been subjected to much criticism both in and out of the Senate.

After stating that tariff reform was near at hand, and reciting that delay had been necessary to cure the House bill of imperfections, he said in part: After twenty years of political progress, of positive growth, of constant development, and of unbroken union, the Democratic party and the American people are within sight of the promised land.
