

PRICES TAKE UPWARD TURN.

Easy Money Favorable to Further Advances.

SUGAR REFINING AGAIN A FEATURE

Amalgamated Copper and Anaconda Also Share in the Rise—Foreign Houses Steady Buyers of American Stocks—Gains in the Railway Quarter—Steel Firmer.

NEW YORK, Dec. 27.—A further advance in prices in the stock market today was entirely based upon the fairly easy conditions prevailing in the money market, and the expectation that the heavy January disbursements for interest and dividends will be succeeded by an active demand for investment securities.

London a Heavy Buyer.

The reopening of business upon the London Stock Exchange brought with it a higher range of prices for American stocks, and foreign houses were steady buyers in this market throughout the morning session, their total takings being upward of 30,000 shares.

Plenty of Call Money.

Money on call was fairly free in supply, a circumstance that was responded to by an immediate advance in the rates for borrowing.

Copper in Demand.

Among the specialties Amalgamated Copper and Anaconda advanced sharply, with nothing novel in the way of news or gossip to be cited in regard to their course.
