MODIFICATION OF REAL ESTATE REGULATIONS WANTED

Big Kick Registered When the New Regulations Were Placed Into Effect.

Although many residents of the country surrounding had been kicking loud and vigorous for some days past, claiming that city residents were allowed to come into their midst, and threatening to put on a short gun quarantine, some of them are now entering a strenuous objection to the quarantine which was placed around the city, and which prevents parties from coming in or going out.

Petitions were received yesterday by the state health officer asking for a modification, but he has not signified his intention of removing the cordon about the city. The petitions and the signers are as follows:

Petition No. 1. Brentwood, Fla., Sept. 10. We, the undersigned, do respectfully petition the State Health Officer, Dr. Joseph Y. Porter, to issue permits to such residents of Brent, Fla., as well as those now residing here, to enter the city of Pensacola after 7 a. m., and return before 5 o'clock p. m., for the purpose of attending to business. We agree, if necessary, to register in crossing the line, and to state the purpose of such visit daily.

This day, before me, a notary public, in and for the state of Florida at large, personally appears James C. Watson, who being duly sworn, declares that the signatures attached to the petition addressed to the state board of health through Dr. J. Y. Porter, and comprising sheets one, two, three and four, are true and valid signatures of the parties subscribed thereto, and also affirms that the general feeling among the residents at Brent's station is in favor of an extension of the line to include said station.

To Dr. Joseph Y. Porter, State Health Officer, Pensacola, Fla. Sir:—The undersigned citizens living in the vicinity of the city of Pensacola, Florida, to the north and west of said town, would respectfully represent that the present restrictions upon travel between the said city and their homes operates as a very great hardship and inconvenience to them in the making of a livelihood, the conduct of their business, and in procuring the necessities of life; that the isolation of their homes is such that they think very little danger is to be apprehended of spreading yellow fever by such intercourse, and they respectfully ask that the present regulations be so changed or modified as to permit a reasonable intercourse between their said neighborhoods and the city of Pensacola.

A Very Exclusive Order. The Order of the Swan is a unique decoration. It has nothing to do with "Lobengrin," but was founded in 1443 by Elector Frederick II, of Brandenburg, surnamed the "Iron Jawed." Of all the orders of knighthood this is most remarkable, inasmuch as only one solitary member in Europe is entitled to wear it, and she is the wife of the reigning Prussian monarch—the German empress. The insignia is very beautiful. It consists of a gold chain set with diamonds, alternated by a ruby heart, to which is suspended a medallion of the Madonna and Child and to which in turn is suspended a silver swan surrounded by a ring or frame of exquisite pearls. With this goes a superb star to be worn on the left shoulder.

Should the empress become a widow she would be compelled to relinquish the insignia and her membership of the Swan to the present crown princess. This order has been worn in turn by the wife of every sovereign occupying the throne of Prussia since 1443, and it is an object of intense pride in the royal family.

How Paul Jones Countered. When the English government denounced John Paul Jones as a pirate the American naval hero neatly countered. Napoleon as a Bogy Man. Thackeray once saw Napoleon on the island of St. Helena. The novelist—he was born in Calcutta in 1811—was on his way to England as a child.
