## LID IS DOWN ON MOBILE TIGHT

Officials Are Enforcing Sunday Law in that Previously Free and Easy City.

The Mobile Item of yesterday says: Yesterday was a busy day for the police department in the enforcing of the Sunday law and the "lid" was on as it never was before. Determined to have the law respected, Chief Rondeau impressed upon beat officers the necessity of keeping the doors of all places selling liquor closed and in all instances frequenters of corner grocery stores were put under the ban of the "move on" ordinance.

Mayor Pat. J. Lyons took an active part in the matter and made a personal tour of the city and instructed the men on the beats as to their duty. Chief Rondeau was out also and the detectives were busy in all parts of the city, but no one violator was discovered. If there was any liquor sold in Mobile yesterday it was done in a way that the police could not learn.

Several instances saloonists, who were in their places of business, and known to the police, were summoned to headquarters and given to understand that they must respect the law.

Determination marked the efforts of the department yesterday and every place was watched, even those operated just beyond the city limits. Mayor Lyons told the chief that the law must be enforced and his wishes were carried out. It is not to be inferred that the department has become careless since the first move to enforce the Sunday law. They have worked just as energetically, but word had reached the ears of Mayor Lyons that the law was being evaded by some who had resorted to methods unknown to the police. If those methods have been used on Sundays heretofore it is positive that those who have violated the law discarded them yesterday.

Complaints have been made that entrances was gained to some places through adjoining restaurants and oyster stands and these were watched but nothing developed. Several policemen were called up before Mayor Lyons and the chief last night to straighten out some misunderstandings as to their orders in connection with enforcing the law. It is very likely that one of these officers will be suspended.

One Arrest in County. The deputy sheriffs on orders from Sheriff Powers kept the lid on tight and only one arrest had been reported. The alleged violator was Richard Riley, proprietor of a saloon and grocery at the corner of Fisher's Alley and Marmotte street. Deputies Cherry and Gibney went there to arrest Alstead Wallace, colored, for raising a disturbance and at the same time notified Riley that he was under arrest.

No disorder is reported from any part of the country with the exception mentioned.

### MOBILE QUARANTINE AGAINST HAVANA RAISED

The Mobile Register of Saturday says: The quarantine against Havana and other points in Cuba was removed yesterday by the executive officers of the Mobile quarantine board. Early yesterday morning Dr. Henry Goldthwaite received a message from Surgeon General Wyman in Washington, proposing that on account of the recent freezes in Mobile the restrictions against Havana be removed. Later in the day the executive members of the Mobile board held a meeting and acted favorably upon the suggestion of the surgeon general.

Surgeon General Wyman stated in his message that the health authorities at Havana would make close inspection of all passengers boarding vessels there and would permit none to leave for Mobile or New Orleans who were not in perfect health.
