

Full Text of Measure Recently Introduced Providing for the Institution.

Following is the full text of the bill recently introduced in congress by Mr. Wiley, of Alabama, providing for a national Tuberculosis sanitarium to be established at Florala:

A bill to establish and maintain a national sanitarium for indigent con-
