## NEW QUARANTINE BILL BY SENATOR MALLORY

Has Introduced One in the Senate Making Many Changes in the Present Regulations of the Marine Hospital Service.

United States Senator Mallory has introduced in the senate a bill which is of more than passing interest to Floridians, inasmuch as it provides for a change in the present quarantine regulations, and imposes further duties upon the officers of the Public Health and Marine Hospital Service. The bill, which is of particular interest in Pensacola, is as follows: Be it enacted by the senate and house of representatives of the United States of America in congress assembled, That as soon as practicable after the approval of this act, the surgeon-general of the public health and marine hospital service of the United States, with the approval of the secretary of the treasury, shall select and designate suitable places for quarantine grounds and anchorages for vessels, at such points on the seacoast of the United States as, in his judgment, are best suited for quarantine grounds and anchorages to prevent the introduction of contagious or infectious diseases into the United States. That in cases in which the title to the land and water so selected and designated is in the United States it shall be the duty of the de-

partment, bureau or official of the United States having custody or possession of such land and water, or any part thereof, on demand of the secretary of the treasury, to deliver the same into his custody and possession, for the use of the public health and marine hospital service, evidencing such delivery by a suitable instrument in writing to be delivered to the secretary of the treasury. That in cases in which the title to such land and water, or any part thereof, is in any other owner than the United States it shall be the duty of the secretary of the treasury to secure the title and possession of the same to the United States, for the use of the public health and marine hospital service, by purchase at a reasonable price, if possible; but if, in his judgment, the price demanded for such property be excessive, he is hereby authorized to apply to the attorney general of the United States to cause to be instituted in the proper tribunal condemnation proceedings, in the name of the United States, for the purpose of acquiring for the United States the title and possession of such land and water, and said attorney general shall, as soon as possible after such application by the secretary of the treasury, cause such proceedings to be instituted and conducted to a conclusion, and the custody and possession of such land and water, when duly required in such condemnation proceedings, shall be delivered to the surgeon general of the public health and marine hospital service.

age for vessels of twenty-five feet draft of water, and shall be distant not less than thirty-five miles from any port or support of entry of the United States. That the secretary of the treasury is hereby authorized and directed to acquire title and possession, for the use of the public health and marine hospital service, of any quarantine station and anchorage of refuge, duly selected and designated, in the manner and by the proceedings authorized and required in section one of this act for acquiring title to and possession of quarantine grounds and anchorages. It is the judgment of the president it is incompatible with the public welfare that a transfer of possession be made to the public health and marine hospital service for a quarantine station and anchorage of refuge, of land and water owned by the United States in the possession or custody of any other executive department than the treasury, the same shall not be done if the president notify the secretary of the treasury in writing of his objection to such transfer. That, on acquiring possession of any land and water selected and designated by him as a quarantine station and anchorage of refuge, the surgeon general of the public health and marine hospital service shall, with the approval of the secretary of the treasury, cause to be published in four such newspapers as he may think proper, once a week for three months, a notice of such selection and designation, together with such rules and regulations as with the approval of the secretary of the treasury he shall adopt and promulgate, requiring vessels with any infectious or contagious diseases among their passengers or crew to go to such quarantine station and anchorage of refuge, to be dealt with there, before visiting any port of the United States; and he shall immediately proceed to establish at such point a quarantine station and anchorage of refuge with facilities for disinfecting vessels and their cargoes, treating in hospital the sick among their passengers and crews, providing for the separation of those among their passengers and crews who are suffering from infectious or contagious disease, and for doing all things necessary to eradicate such diseases from such vessels, their cargoes, passengers and crews.

Sec. 4. That the surgeon general of the public health and marine hospital service, subject to the approval of the secretary of the treasury, shall have the control, direction, and management of all quarantine grounds and anchorages and of all quarantine stations and anchorages of refuge established by authority of the United States; but nothing in this act shall be construed to authorize any vessel or any person released from quarantine detention by authority of said surgeon general, to enter any state or territory of the United States, or the District of Columbia, against the expressed objection of the lawful health authorities of such state, territory or district.

Sec. 5. That any vessel, or any officer of any vessel, or other person other than state or municipal, health or quarantine officers, trespassing or otherwise entering within the limits of any quarantine grounds and anchorages of refuge, or departing therefrom in disregard of the quarantine rules and regulations, or without the permission of the officer in charge of such quarantine ground and anchorage or of such quarantine station and anchorage of refuge, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to arrest, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$300, or by imprisonment for not more than one year, or both, in the discretion of the court. That

Sec. 6. any master or owner of any vessel violating any provision of this act, or any provision of an act entitled "An Act granting additional powers and imposing additional duties on the marine hospital service, approved February fifteenth, eighteen hundred and ninety-three" or violating any rule or regulation made in accordance with this act, or said act of February fifteenth, eighteen hundred and ninety-three, relating to the inspection of vessels, or to the prevention of the introduction of contagious or infectious diseases into the United States, or any master, owner, or agent of any vessel making a false statement relative to the sanitary condition of such vessel or its contents, or as to the health of any passenger or person thereon, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than five hundred dollars, or imprisonment for not more than one year, or both, in the discretion of the court.

Sec. 6. That from and after the approval of this act the salary of the surgeon general of the public health and marine hospital service shall be seven thousand five hundred dollars per annum, payable monthly. That the sum of — dollars is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated to be paid on the requisition of the surgeon general of the public health and marine hospital service, approved by the secretary of the treasury, for the purpose of carrying into effect the provisions of this act.

Sec. 7. That all laws and parts of laws in conflict with the provisions of this act be, and the same are, hereby repealed.

## PENSACOLA SHIP IS REPORTED IN DISTRESS

The Nakomis, Owned by Thos. and Arthur Johnson Spoken by Steamer Heathburn.

The schooner Nakomis, owned by Thos. and Arthur Johnson of this city, and which was purchased over a year ago in New York, is reported to be in bad condition in the gulf. The vessel, according to the report of the British steamer Heathburn, which reached Galveston on December 26, was waterlogged.

She has on board a cargo of lumber, and was sighted in latitude 28 north, longitude 87:37 west. The steamer stood by and offered to take off the crew, but the captain of the schooner refused to leave the vessel, as did the crew. The steamer proceeded on to Galveston and made a report of the vessel.

It is supposed that the Nakomis was caught in the storm of some ten days ago. Her position at the time she was sighted was approximately 125 miles directly south of Pensacola.

### Baffled.

### About Breathing.

In the ordinary respiration of man sixteen or seventeen cubic inches of atmospheric air pass into the lungs twenty times a minute or a cubic foot every five and one-quarter minutes. 274 cubic feet in twenty-four hours. The lungs hold 2.80 cubic feet. At each respiration 1.375 of oxygen is converted into carbonic acid gas. The nitrogen inspired and expired is exactly equal. During the act of inspiration the lungs have been found to be the coldest parts of the body.
