

HOW CARRANZA MOVES THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT

WONDERFUL MOBILITY OF CONSTITUTIONALIST TROOPS NO MORE REMARKABLE THAN THAT OF THE ADMINISTRATION.

Victoria, Mex., July 26.—While the mobility of the Constitutional troops in the present revolution has excited admiration of military experts from all over the world, the mobility of the administrative forces have been no less remarkable. With the burden of administering the affairs of a portion of Mexico, embracing hundreds of thousands of square miles on their shoulders, faced with the necessity of transporting, feeding and paying 100,000 men in the field and supplying them with arms and ammunition, and with the pressure of international affairs necessitating immediate solution through intricate diplomatic channels heavy upon the general Carranza and his administrative officers have moved thousands of miles under tremendous difficulties. There never has been a permanent capital or headquarters for the Constitutional administration.

Wherever General Carranza goes, the records, archives and administrative forces of the Constitutional government accompany him. Frequent changes of base necessitated by political and military exigency have so accustomed his official family to prompt removals that they change their scene of operations without confusion. The archives, documents and records of the various departments are carried in padded wooden cases numbered and painted with a different color for each department. Within thirty minutes after the order to move is received, all papers and correspondence are packed, loaded on wagons and taken to General Carranza's special train while the secretaries change in car seats snatching a nap before the next stop will set them to work anew.

GET READY QUICKLY.
Within thirty minutes after a new town has been reached the contents of the cases are ready for systematic handling. The weather-worn signs which indicate the temporary quarters of the acting ministers have been hung before the doors of whatever building happens handy as the temporary capital. General Carranza's personal baggage operator is never far from him. There are few hours when he is not in direct touch with affairs in Mexico and the outside world.

Carranza's private secretary, Gustavo Espinosa Mireles, in addition to his other duties, is official censor of press matter from Carranza's headquarters. He meets the newspaper men twice a day to give them information. Much of General Carranza's personal correspondence is handled by Mr. Mireles on long automobile trips to the country on which he and General Carranza are along and can work uninterruptedly. There is no eight hour day at Carranza's headquarters, where the clerks work from early morning until late at night.

CARRANZA A BUSY MAN.
Five of Carranza's hours for riding. He usually takes a brisk horseback ride immediately after that no. Many of his most important conferences have been held on these rides. Many a business man, both Mexican and American has been dismayed when invited to ride with the chief and discuss his affairs at that hour. From the time General Carranza returns from his ride until he goes to bed at 1 or 2 a. m. every moment is occupied. His reception rooms both at his residence and his office are filled constantly with visitors. These vary from poor women who come to beg five pesos, to oil men, cattle men, and mining men who come to discuss deals involving millions and foreign representatives who come to discuss the future of Mexico.

Peraldi, Carranza's major domo (foreman) who has lived in Paris and New York, sorts out these visitors, finds a time for each and gives the general leisure time to attend the social functions which are offered him in every town he visits. Among the business officers of them are Isidro Fabella, acting minister of foreign relations, and Ignacio Bonillas, acting minister of communications and fomento.

Upon Mr. Fabella has fallen the burden of the most important diplomatic exchanges. Mr. Bonilla is handling thousands of miles of railroad and telegraph lines which have been the plaything of warring factions for the last four years. The pressure of work in issuing of mining titles alone in his department has been immense.
