

MERIDIAN, Miss., Aug. 15.—At a mass meeting of citizens, held in the city hall tonight a committee of 12 to be known as the Meridian Welfare League, was appointed to handle government food products to be secured in carload lots from New Orleans and sold to the people of Meridian at actual cost. The committee personnel is as follows: H. H. Weir, Kemper J. Johnson, Jos. W. Jones, J. O. Smith, R. L. Smith, C. Conley, W. M. Hall, Cliff Williams, E. J. Gallagher, J. W. Bostick, W. F. Pigford, and H. Thornton. The first six named are representatives of various labor unions and the latter six are business men. The Welfare League will get busy at once and order government supplies from the New Orleans base and distribute them as fast as they arrive in the city. Two carloads have already been arranged for and the league will secure as many more carloads as the government will allow for this city and section.
