A DEFICIT

For the First Third of the Fiscal Year of \$32,885,000,

Or at the Rate of \$98,000,000 for the Entire Year.

The Deficit for October Was \$7,698,000—Receipts for the First Third of the Year \$8,387,000 Less Than Last Year—Principal Loss Was in Customs.

WASHINGTON, Nov. 2.—The treasury official comparative statement of the receipts and expenditures for the fiscal year to date and for October was issued Monday. It shows the deficit for the first third of the current fiscal year to have been \$32,885,000, or at the rate of \$98,000,000 for the current year. The deficit for October was \$7,698,000. The receipts for the first third of the year were \$103,458,000 or \$8,015,000 less for the corresponding period of 1895. The expenditures for the first third of the current year were \$138,347,000 or \$8,387,000 greater than for the corresponding period of 1895. The principal loss in receipts has been in customs which have declined from \$53,143,000 in the first third of 1895 to \$40,966,000 for the corresponding period of 1896. Internal revenue receipts are practically the same as they were for the corresponding period of 1895. The receipts for October, 1896, were \$26,282,000 against \$27,001,000 in October, 1895. The principal items of increase in expenses have been in the civil list which has increased from \$32,309,000 in the first third of 1895 to \$40,576,000 for the first third of 1896.

The expenditures in the war department have increased nearly \$4,000,000 in the like period; in the navy nearly \$4,000,000 and in interest charges nearly \$1,000,000. The expenditures for October were \$33,978,000 against \$34,503,000 for October, 1895, the saving being almost wholly in pensions.

SCARED ITALIANS

In a Panic on an Electric Car—One Man Was Killed and Several Injured. NEWARK, N. J., Nov. 2.—Through the flashing of the battery in an electric car on Mt. Prospect avenue early Monday morning, terror seized the passengers and they sprang from the car. One man was killed, one fatally hurt and four others seriously injured. The car was going north with a gang of 39 Italian laborers. At Mt. Prospect place the controlling stand flashed out. The car was under full headway. The Italians became panic stricken and dashed headlong out of the windows and over the rear platform. Laubuska Angelo landed upon his head, breaking his neck. Gaisseppe was nearly scalped by dashing his head through the glass. The others were injured by jumping.

Special Weather Bulletin.

CHICAGO, Nov. 2.—The weather bureau issues the following special bulletin for Tuesday: Generally fair weather will prevail in the states of the Missouri valley and in Colorado, Wyoming and Kansas. Rain or snow will fall in Minnesota and Montana. In Iowa and Missouri rain will be followed by fair weather in central and western portions Tuesday. Rain is indicated for Wisconsin, upper Michigan and western lower Michigan. In Illinois and Indiana showers will occur, with prospects for fair weather in Illinois Tuesday afternoon.

A Philanthropic Scheme.

NEW YORK, Nov. 2.—Mrs. Seth Low, wife of President Low, of Columbia college, Mrs. Edward Lauterbach and other philanthropic women will start a new scheme to make servant girls happy and contented. It is a working-women's club, where domestic servants can have all the benefits of the most up-to-date of women's clubs. They will meet at present at 312 West Fifty-second street, where lectures on domestic science will be given once a week by Mrs. Helen Campbell, of Wisconsin university.

Ivory Asks for Protection.

LONDON, Nov. 2.—Edward J. Ivory, alias Bell, the alleged dynamiter, who is under remand for further examination in the Bow street police court, having applied to United States Ambassador Bayard for the protection of the embassy as an American citizen, the embassy will send a representative to the Bow street police court when the next hearing comes up next Friday, to watch the proceedings with a view of preserving the prisoner's rights as a citizen of the United States.

Clock Manufacturers Assign.

NEW YORK, Nov. 2.—Max Hamburger & Co., clock manufacturers at Nos. 616 and 618 Broadway, assigned Monday to George Hayman. They started business in June, 1895. The assignment was caused by the suicide of Jos. M. Hamburger, father of the senior partner, who had guaranteed their accounts. Liabilities, \$27,000; assets, same.

Bankers and Brokers Fail.

PROVIDENCE, R. I., Nov. 2.—Miller & Vaughan, bankers and brokers at 23 and 25 Exchange street, made an assignment Monday. Several well-known speculators were caught for large amounts. The liabilities are estimated at \$150,000. Miller is a member of the New York stock exchange.

Senator Palmer Closes His Campaign.

SPRINGFIELD, Ill., Nov. 2.—Senator John M. Palmer left Monday morning for Jacksonville, where he closed his campaign Monday night. Senator Palmer is much fatigued by his campaigning tour. He will return home Tuesday in time to vote and will receive the returns at his home.

A Printer Fouly Murdered.

INDIANOLA, Miss., Nov. 2.—The body of J. J. Williams, printer, was found in a cornfield half a mile from Indianola. Knife wounds showed that the man had been murdered. The sheriff, with bloodhounds, is on the trail of the murderers. Two men have been lodged in jail on suspicion.
