DECREASED VOLUME

In Sale of Stocks, But Prices Held Up Well.

New York, Nov. 14.—The striking fact about today's stock market was the decreased volume of trading. Yesterday's reaction was checked and quite an imposing show of strength was made afterwards, but there was no renewal of inordinate buying or a demand which carried prices up with a rush all through the last week. The market dropped back into ordinary importance, business continuing on a large scale compared with the normal, but the movement of prices obviously depended on artificial stimulants. The selling orders are still operating from outside sources, but powerful support by bull pools, who are still operating for an advance, checked the decline and secured control of the market almost immediately. There was a final rally, but lacking in snap, and not well maintained, the market closing irregular. Pacific Mail, Linseed Oil and the preferred steel stocks were active and reactionary. The total shares traded in numbered 948,932.
