ANTI-MONOPOLY CONVENTION.

Meeting in Chicago of the National Anti-Monopoly Convention—A Permanent Organization Proposed—The Platform Adopted.

At the afternoon session of the convention on Credentials presented a report. There was a contest in one State only—California. The committee reported in favor of the admission of the delegates from the regular Anti-Monopoly organization of California, leaving Kearney and Maybell out.

After exciting remarks by several delegates and Kearney himself a vote was taken by States on the admission of Kearney and Maybell, and they were rejected by a vote of 118 to 7.

J. F. Henry, of Brooklyn, N. Y., was elected Permanent Chairman; C. C. Post, of Indiana, Secretary; J. R. Buchanan, of Missouri, Treasurer; and J. C. Johnson, of St. John, Missouri, Assistant Secretary. Ten Vice-Presidents were also chosen.

The Anti-Monopolists continued their Convention yesterday morning, President Henry in the chair.

After remarks by several delegates, a resolution was adopted by the convention, to the effect that the delegates from the regular Anti-Monopoly organization of California, leaving Kearney and Maybell out, be admitted to the convention.
