Scotchman, Blind from Birth, Recovers Vision After Operation—Based by What He Sees.

A most touching and pretty story comes from the little Scotch village of Croft Head, Bridge of Weir, where a man of 30 years, blind from his birth, has been given sight by Dr. Maitland Ramsey, of the Glasgow Ophthalmic Institute.

He brought the case to the notice of the institution. Carruth was taken there and operated upon. He is now home again, with good sight.

In describing the sensations when light first dawned upon him he said the first face he saw was that of the doctor. He was bewildered, but thought he must be looking on a face for the first time.

His first meeting under the altered conditions with his mother was the most pathetic incident of the recovery.

"Lovely" was the word he used when he gazed upon her face, and the mother's joyous cry: "Eh, laddie, you can see! you can see!" made the hearts of those who heard it throb in sympathy.

CZAR PLANS FOR DAUGHTER.

Scheme of Education in Preparation So That Girl May Be Fitted to Reign in Event There is No Son.

The Taglisch Rundschau of Berlin reports the czar is seriously considering an alteration in the law of succession, with a view to enabling his eldest daughter to ascend the Russian throne, failing a son.

This project inevitably will meet with strong opposition, especially from the disinherited granddukes.

It is reported that the czar shortly will make a pilgrimage to the hermit father, Serafin, at Sarafskaja, in the province of Tambours, and that he will be accompanied by the court and the ministers.

REVENGE FOR EARLY CRUELTY

The Novel Defense Offered by a German Officer Charged with Brutality.

Noncommissioned Officer Kisch, of Berlin, who has been sent to prison for a year and a half for maltreating soldiers, said he inflicted torments on the recruits because he had been compelled to suffer when he himself was a recruit.

He boxed the ears of almost all the recruits daily, prodded them in the back, struck them in the face, used his whip liberally and amused himself between times by chasing the men under beds, making them scurry under five beds as often as 50 times in succession.

HE DENOUNCES DRUGS

Chicago Physician Says He Is Losing Faith in Use of Medicine.

Dr. L. H. Mattler Tells Medical Society That Proper Exercise, Baths, Etc., Do More to Cure People Than Knife or Prescriptions.

"The medical profession of to-day places too much dependence upon the knife and prescriptions. I am daily losing confidence in drugs, but at the same time I am winning confidence in various forms of exercise, in baths, electricity, massage and in the effect of daily thought upon the general health of patients."

The declarations of Dr. Mattler followed a paper upon medical gymnastics read by Dr. W. M. Fitch, in which it was claimed that a graduated system of gymnastics under the direction of a competent physician would work wonders with the ill of many invalids.

"That gymnastics, out-of-door exercise and high altitudes, all of which expand the lungs, are among the most efficient of aids in the treatment of pulmonary complaints has long been an established fact," said Dr. Fitch. "The same principles which make these agencies effective for pulmonary complaints apply also to the treatment of numerous other forms of disease."

"The growth of osteopathy and the constant increase of the physical culture schools are things for which the medical profession itself has been largely responsible," said Dr. A. N. Caldwell. "Too long have we neglected these movement systems and left mechanical therapeutics to the layman, to superannuated pugilists and worn-out athletes."
