Women and Colorado's Troubles.

Colorado is in a lawless condition; therefore woman suffrage evidently has done no good. This is now the favorite argument of the opponents. They might as well say, "Colorado is in a lawless condition, therefore the schools and churches of Colorado have evidently done no good." They have not done everything, therefore they have not done anything. A highly logical argument.

While differing intensely upon other subjects, the one point upon which all factions in Colorado agree is in testifying that woman suffrage is a good thing, and is in no way responsible for the troubles. Gov. Penbody has lately written a letter to this effect to an organization of women on the Pacific Coast; the Western Federation of Miners passed a resolution endorsing woman suffrage at its annual meeting; and Hon. John L. Shafrath and Governor-elect Adams have publicly expressed themselves to the same effect on occasions too numerous to mention. When people so radically opposed to each other on every other question are all unanimous on this one point, we may be pretty sure their testimony is true.—Alice Stone Blackwell.

NOTICE OF SALE OF BONDS.

Sealed proposals will be received at the Office of the clerk of the incorporated Village of Perrysburg, State of Ohio, until 12 o'clock noon, Standard Time, of Wednesday, March 1st, 1905, for the purchase of bonds of said village, in the aggregate sum of five thousand, two hundred and ninety three dollars and sixty four cents (\$5293.64). Said bonds shall be numbered from 1 to 5 inclusive. Said bonds shall be in denominations of one thousand dollars (\$1000.00) each, and number 5 of said bonds shall be in the denomination of one thousand, two hundred and ninety-three dollars and sixty-four cents (\$1293.64). Said bonds shall be dated March 1st, 1905, and shall run for a period of fifteen (15) years; and be made payable at the Fourth National Bank in the City of New York, state of New York, with interest from the date thereof, at the rate of five (5) per cent per annum payable semi-annually, on the first day of September and March of each year, at the same place, issued for the purpose of paying said village's share of the cost and expense of grading, draining, curbing and macadamizing Front street from the East line of Hickory street to the West line of West Boundary street, and under and by authority conferred by Section 53 of an act of the General Assembly of the State of Ohio, entitled "An act to provide for the organization of cities and incorporated villages and to restrict their powers of taxation, assessment, borrowing money, contracting debts, and loaning their credit so as to prevent the abuse of such powers, as required by the statutes of Ohio, and to repeal all sections of the Revised Statutes inconsistent herewith," passed October 22d, 1902, and under and in accordance with a certain ordinance of said Village entitled "An ordinance to provide for the issue of general street improvement bonds of the incorporated village of Perrysburg, Ohio, to pay said corporation's part of the cost and expense of grading, draining, curbing and macadamizing Front street from the East line of Hickory street to the West line of West Boundary street," passed October 13th, 1904.

Said bonds will be sold to the highest and best bidder for not less than par and accrued interest.

All bidders will be required to state, in addition to par and accrued interest, such premium as they may offer, the amount of said premium to be specified plainly in writing. They will also be required to deposit with their bid an amount of money or certified check drawn "without condition as to payment" on the Citizens Banking Company, of Perrysburg, Ohio, payable to the Treasurer of said village, equal to at least five (5) per cent of the par value of the bonds, as a guarantee of good faith, and that if the bid is accepted the bidder will receive and pay for such bonds as may be issued as above set forth within ten (10) days from the time of such award. No bid will be considered if not accompanied by money or check as aforesaid. When the bids have been examined and the award made, according to law, all moneys or checks deposited as guaranty shall be returned to the depositors, except that of the successful bidder which shall be considered and accepted as part payment for the bonds so awarded or sold; and said guaranty shall accordingly be immediately paid into the treasury of the Village of Perrysburg by the Clerk; and should there be any repudiation of the contract or agreement, or refusal to accept or pay for the bonds so sold, then in that case the deposit shall be forfeited to the village of Perrysburg and shall become the property of the said Village of Perrysburg in compensation for the loss and expense attending the sale of said bonds, not by way of penalty, but as damages for the repudiation of the bid.

The Council of the incorporated Village of Perrysburg reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

Bids should be sealed and endorsed "Bids for Street Improvement Bonds," and delivered to T. M. PRANEY, Clerk, January 27th, 1905.
