

OLA HUMPHREY IN "A MODERN GIRL."

When the Messrs. Shubert set about to cast the various roles in their production of Ruth C. Mitchell's new and sparkling four act comedy, "A Modern Girl," which obtained its premiere just eight weeks ago at the Cort Theatre, Chicago, and which will come to the Auditorium, Toledo, for Dec. 25, 26 and 27 with Xmas and Saturday matinees, they were more than fortunate in placing Ola Humphrey under contract for one of the principal roles.
