FARM AND ORCHARD.

Alcohol solution can be used cheaply for an anti-freeze mixture for the auto and other gasoline engines. The proper strength of mixture for various temperature follows: 10 per cent solution for 20 degrees above, 20 per cent solution for 16 degrees above, 30 per cent solution for 0 degrees above, 36 per cent solution for 10 degrees below. In case a mixture of 20 or more per cent alcohol freezes, it simply forms a soft mush that has no bursting power. Specially prepared anti-freeze mixtures may be used, but are likely to contain sulphur, lime and other chemicals injurious to the metals of the engine.

The fall and early winter months afford an excellent opportunity to clean up the orchard and to wage a fight against fruit diseases, according to the department of horticulture, Ohio State University. All diseased and blight infested parts of the trees should be cut out and burned. The blight during the past season has been worse than usual and care must be taken to prevent its spread if the orchard is to be saved. In cutting out blighted parts the dead bark should be cut away, leaving in sharp contrast the live portion. The dead part is the lowest margin of the blight.


WILL ENFORCE HIGHWAY LAWS.

Notice is hereby given that the following sections of State Highway Laws are operative and will be strictly enforced in Perryburg township:

Section 159. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to construct a walk or dig a ditch across a public highway outside of any municipality or build a fence thereon or otherwise impair such highway, without the consent of the county highway superintendent, township highway superintendent or township trustees.

Section 291. Whoever digs up, removes, excavates or places any earth or mud upon any portion of any public highway or builds any fence upon the same, without legal authority or permission so to do, shall be fined not more than two hundred dollars nor less than ten dollars. Each day that such person continues to dig up, remove or excavate any portion of the public highway shall constitute a separate offense.
