The first floor plan has a library which is 25 1/2 by 32 feet, in connection with which there is a museum room, 25 1/2 by 32 feet. On this same floor are three class rooms of substantially the same size, and near the entrance to the right as you enter is a reception room 13 1/2 by 14 feet, and between the reception room and the class room comes a lavatory, 14 by 9 feet. This gives the length of the building on the ground 110 feet, while its average width is 72 feet.
