The Situation at Chicago.

In my last special from Chicago yesterday I stated that I thought either Blaine or Allison would head the ticket. The situation I think unchanged, unless it may be in favor of the dark horse.

About the only dark horses spoken of are ex-Governor Porter, of Indiana, Major McKinley and Governor Foraker, of Ohio. Both the Allison and Blaine factions are flitting with Harrison—the Blaine men with the intention of inducing him to take second place and the Allison men have hopes of finally winning the Harrison forces to the support of their favorite. It is not, I think, either the wish or the intention of either faction to nominate Harrison, although the ballots would seem to indicate that he was gaining strength.

Such, in my judgment, is the situation, based upon information obtained from the most authentic sources at 8 o'clock last evening. Situations change so rapidly, however, that new combinations are possible now being considered and attempted. Until the end comes the result is a great uncertainty. T. G. B.

CHICAGO, June 23.—As the time of the meeting of the convention arrives the Gresham movement is almost lost sight of in the great fight pending between Harrison and Allison. Senator Cameron has prevailed upon Quay, who leads the Pennsylvania forces, to go into an Allison combination, and the junior senator from Pennsylvania went into the convention last night with fifty-five votes for Allison, and a firm conviction that his candidate would be nominated on the second or third ballot. He was confused by the Harrison movement in New York and got Hastings to move an adjournment in order to gain time. Quay was at work all night fixing up the Allison fences. If Quay cannot succeed with the Allison movement he may run in with the Harrison side, but is more likely to join in a combination of the field against the Indiana candidate. The friends of Harrison are claiming that the Blaine people are coming over to their man and that he will succeed after three ballots. But a good many long-headed people are watching a man sitting in the Ohio delegation, who is a promising dark horse in the race. The convention was called to order at 10:05, but it was not until twenty minutes later that the proceedings were formally opened by Chairman Estee calling upon ex-Senator Warner Miller, of New York, to preside. Bishop Samuel Fellows, of Chicago, delivered the invocation.

The convention proceeded to another ballot which, if the friends of Harrison is a correct one, will be the last of the session, as adjournment will be taken as soon as the ballot is completed. At the conference of the representatives of Sherman, Alger, Harrison, Blaine and Allison delegations, which was held this morning, at the Grand Pacific, between 12 and 4 o'clock, M. H. DeYoung, representative of the Blaine interest, made a statement that if Harrison was nominated it would be utterly impossible to elect him. He could not possibly carry a Pacific coast state, nor would he be able to carry any of the larger states where the labor element predominated, because he had voted against the Chinese bill and treaty, and every phase of it, and he had committed a still greater crime in voting to naturalize Chinese and give them the right of suffrage, and that Allison was exactly in the same boat. The statement made by DeYoung created great consternation. Colonel Henderson, representative of the Sherman interest, made a statement that he thought De-
