AN APOLOGY AND THE CAUSE

The Silver Belt owes an apology to its readers and the public for the non-issue of the Tuesday morning edition, which was due to the shutdown of the plant of the Gas & Electric company. It was hoped that there would be both gas and electricity last night, but there was none of the former in the company's mains, and the Silver Belt this morning is of hand composition. There is none to blame for the shutdown except the Gas & Electric company, which allowed its fuel supply to exhaust itself, with almost the entire city dependent on them for light and electric power, and apparently making no effort to secure fuel until at a time when it was too late to secure any. Some of the inconvenience caused by the shutdown entailed considerable loss to the city, and in some cases was not a loss which could be computed in dollars and cents.

This incident naturally brings up the question of municipal control or regulation of public utilities. The Silver Belt has been incorporated and the incorporation has been taken effect which time, to the activities of the city. There have been no occurrences of this nature in the future. In southern cities in other sections, the public have been disposed to favor the capitalists from whom come in and request for public utilities. They secure their franchises without payment of a cent into the coffers of the municipality and, as it has been in a number of cases, they immediately proceed to take advantage of the public which they have at their mercy. It is to be hoped that the municipal government of Globe, which will be a reality in a very short time, will look well into this phase of the franchise business.
