ARTICLE I. The names of the aforesaid incorporators are H. H. Bru, M. E. Bru and S. L. Gibson.

ARTICLE II. The name of the incorporation shall be and is The H. H. Bru Company, and its principal place of business shall be at the town of Globe, County of Gila, Territory of Arizona...

ARTICLE III. The nature of the business to be transacted by the corporation is a general brokerage, mining, real estate and insurance business...

ARTICLE IV. The capital stock of this corporation shall be and is Twenty-five Thousand (\$25,000.00) Dollars, divided into Two Hundred and Fifty (250) shares of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars each.

ARTICLE V. The corporate existence of this corporation shall be twenty-five years from the date of filing articles with the Auditor of the Territory of Arizona.

ARTICLE VI. A board of three directors, who shall be stockholders in this corporation, shall manage its affairs.

ARTICLE VII. The officers of this corporation shall be a President, Treasurer and Secretary, who shall be elected annually by the Board of Directors...

ARTICLE VIII. The directors of this corporation, from its organization and until the first Monday in January, 1908, and until its successors are elected and qualified, are H. H. Bru, M. E. Bru and S. L. Gibson...

ARTICLE IX. Other offices may be created or abolished by the Board of Directors, or by by-laws of this corporation, and the said offices shall be filled by election or appointment from time to time as the directors see fit, or the by-laws shall provide.

ARTICLE X. A corporate seal and by-laws shall be adopted by this corporation, through its Board of Directors, and these articles of incorporation and said by-laws may be repealed or amended by the majority vote of the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE XI. The corporate indebtedness of this corporation shall at no time exceed sixteen thousand (\$16,000.00) dollars.

ARTICLE XII. The private property of the stockholders and officers of this corporation shall be exempt from corporate liability.

ARTICLE XIII. The nature of the business to be transacted by the corporation is a general brokerage, mining, real estate and insurance business...

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ARTICLE XX. A corporate seal and by-laws shall be adopted by this corporation, through its Board of Directors, and these articles of incorporation and said by-laws may be repealed or amended by the majority vote of the Board of Directors.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE GLOBE-ARIZONA COPPER COMPANY Know All Men by These Presents: That we, the undersigned, do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the Territory of Arizona, and to that end, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation: I. The name of the corporation shall be THE GLOBE-ARIZONA COPPER COMPANY, and the names of the incorporators are J. B. Newman, S. L. Gibson, F. L. Toombs, J. A. Bordeaux and E. M. Toombs, all residents of the Territory of Arizona. II. The principal place of transacting the business of this corporation and its principal office shall be at Globe, Gila County, Territory of Arizona, and at such other places as the Board of Directors may from time to time designate. III. The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation is as follows, to wit: To purchase, lease, bond or otherwise acquire, own, exchange, sell or otherwise dispose of, pledge, mortgage, hypothecate and deal in mines and mining claims, mineral deposits, mineral lands, water and water rights, easements, servitudes, right of way, shares and interests in the capital or other stock and properties of this and other corporations, and to work, mine, explore, develop and operate same; and to erect mills, smelters and other plants necessary for the reduction of ores; to own, handle and control real estate and mercantile business; to borrow money and execute notes, bonds, mortgages or deeds of trust to secure the same, and to exercise in respect to all such bonds, mortgages, notes, shares of capital or other stock and other securities and obligations, any and all rights, powers and privileges as an individual owner thereof, including the right to vote any shares of stock so held by it to the same extent that a natural person might or could do; and, in general, to do all things necessary to the proper conduct of the business of this corporation in this Territory and elsewhere, not inconsistent with the laws of the United States and the laws of the Territory of Arizona. IV. The amount of capital stock of this corporation shall be One Million Five Hundred Thousand (\$1,500,000.00) Dollars divided into one million five hundred thousand (1,500,000) shares of the par value of One (\$1.00) Dollar each, which shall be fully paid and non-assessable. Such capital stock, or any part thereof, may be sold for cash, or may be issued in payment for property, services, rights or interests purchased or otherwise acquired, and shall be issued in payment thereof upon such terms and conditions as the Board of Directors may determine. V. The time of the commencement of this corporation shall be the date of the filing of these Articles of Incorporation for record in the office of the County Recorder of Gila County, Territory of Arizona, and a certified copy filed with the Territorial Auditor, and the termination thereof shall be twenty-five years thereafter, and its charter rights may be renewed from time to time, not exceeding twenty-five years at a time, perpetually.
