ORDINANCE NO. TWENTY-FIVE

An Ordinance Amending Ordinance Number Seventeen. Be it ordained by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Globe: SECTION I. Section III of Ordinance Number Seventeen of the City of Globe is hereby amended to read as follows: SECTION III. It shall be unlawful for any person to maintain within the said fire limits any tent or canvas covered building, or other structure with canvas or cloth roof or lining, or any stove pipes running through any side or roof opening in any building; nor shall any person build or erect any building or addition to any building within said fire limits, of any material other than brick, stone, cement, or other non-combustible material.

SECTION II.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION III.

An Ordinance Amending Ordinance Number Seventeen. Be it ordained by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Globe: SECTION I. Section I of Ordinance Number Seventeen is hereby amended to read as follows: SECTION I.
