LOCAL STOCKS HELD UP FIRM

Good Bank Statement Fails to Have Appreciable Effect on the Eastern Markets—Present Outlook Not Encouraging and All News is Bearish.

(By I. N. Kinsey) GLOBE, May 18.—The present apparent stagnation in New York and Boston and the prevailing low prices have so far failed to have any severe effect on local stocks, although trading is extremely dull. The advance in Helvetia was the only curb feature of the day, sales being made at \$4.37. Globe Consolidated remains strong with \$12.25 the ruling price, while sales were made during the day at \$12.37. Arizona Commercial sold off a point and Superior & Boston was offered freely in the Copper market at \$3.25, while bids of \$3.00 Country at \$3.25, and bids of \$3.00 failed to bring out a share. Calumet & Globe could not be had for less than \$1.62. There were no features on the Boston curb or the New York exchange on which there was but a short session. Paine Webber of the Boston says: Public interest tells the whole story. Stocks are sagging of their own weight and we see nothing in sight to make a change. We advise liquidating speculative lines and waiting until the market shows some tendency to move. Several stocks are selling too high in comparison with others. Range earnings are more than Mohawk, but is selling three points less. Sell Mohawk until ratio changes. North Butte should not sell any higher than Copper Range.
