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**Asks Heavy Damages**  
Dr. Charles Prentice of Chicago, who is at the Waldorf-Astoria, said last night that he had, through his lawyer, Frank Brundage of 32 Liberty street, begun suit against the North German Lloyd Steamship company for \$250,000 damages because of the action of Captain H. Morgenstern and the doctor of the steamship Koenigin Luise in burying over the side Mrs. Prentice, who died at sea.

Mrs. Prentice, with her daughter, was on the way from Italy to New York, the steamer having sailed from Genoa on April 18. On April 27, Mrs. Prentice, who, it was said, had been suffering from a serious affection, died in her berth. Her daughter insisted on having the body of her mother embalmed and conveyed to this port. Dr. H. Leber, the ship's physician, who, it was said, took counsel with the royal Italian commissioner, who looks after the comfort and safety of immigrants, advised Captain Morgenstern that the body could not be kept on the ship.

Against the most vigorous protests and pleadings of the weeping daughter, the body of Mrs. Prentice was dropped overboard the same day, a prayer being read as the ship stopped. Flags were lowered and only a few in the darkness stood around the open gangway when the weighted body was shoved overboard.—New York World.
