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Expect No Decline in Copper

In spite of the many rumors regarding the possibility of a decline in the price of copper and of the report from the London market of a sharp decline in G. M. B. in that market, the more important copper interests in this city say there is absolutely no indication of any decline in the price of Lake or Electrolytic grades in this country. It is true that there is practically no business being transacted at present, but that is for the reason that consumers are well supplied up to the first of July and have not yet commenced to look after their requirements for the third and fourth quarters of the year. That inquiries will soon be made for consumers' requirements for those coming quarters is the expectation of all producers. It is possible that consumers are holding off in the hopes that some change in conditions may occur and that there may be some decline from the present high price basis. Producers, however, declare that consumption has largely increased; some say the increase has been nearly 30 per cent over last year's consumption, whereas the output of copper has increased less than 5 per cent throughout the country. So far as can be ascertained, there is no immediate indication of any let-up in demand and when the buying movement does begin it is likely to be very active and excited.—Boston Financial News.
