AMALGAMATED TAKES A DROP

Balance of List Follow Suit—New York Forces Nipissing Down to \$8.37—Some Further Rumors in Regard to Reduction in Price of Metal.

GLOBE, July 29.—Payne, Webber & Co. of Boston say: Money was tighter and the situation abroad was serious. English consuls are selling at lower prices now than they have been for over sixty years. The condition of H. H. Rogers is far more serious than at first supposed and traders sold Amalgamated. The short interest was very much increased today and a rally will come in a short time. It is hard to tell just how long the present dullness will continue, but we do not think that it will last for any length of time. We advise lightening up accounts and being ready to meet the conditions which may be caused by a squeeze in money. No further bad news from H. H. Rogers.

The whole market was off yesterday, the coppers in particular. Amalgamated Copper sold off two dollars, closing weak at \$88.25. Anaconda showed an equal loss, closing at \$57. North Butte and Copper Range are off a couple of points and were offered freely at the close. Nipissing surprised everyone and sold off two dollars a share, closing weak at \$8.37. Old Dominion sold off in sympathy with the balance of the list and was offered freely at the close at \$42.50. Superior & Boston was offered at \$3, with no takers. Globe Consolidated sagged a little, closing at \$13.75. The market for Calumet and Globe seems to be dead; the stock was offered yesterday at \$1.37 with no takers. A number of local people seem assured that the market is due for a substantial rise within the next couple of months and are quietly salting away Old Dominion and other attractive local issues.

MARKET WEAKER RALLY EXPECTED

Market Declined from One to Three Points from Opening—Consider Market Good Purchase—Some Trading in Local Stocks—Recovery Expected.

GLOBE, July 29.—The market experienced quite a slump during today's session, declining from one to three points through the whole list. The condition of the market is somewhat uncertain and these slumps are likely to

occur at any time after an advance of a few points in the market. We would always adhere to a strictly traders' position and take one to two points profit where they are shown. Operators should continue to confine their trading only to the best class of stocks or the leaders in the bull movements of the market.

From a report by the treasurer of Utah Consolidated to a Boston broker it is reported a full denial of the story printed in the News Bureau regarding the faulting of the lode, etc. We would advise picking up this stock at the present prices and believe that with any improvement in the market conditions it will be one of the leaders in an upward movement. In our judgment Old Dominion around the present price is a snap and should be bought.

We are of the opinion stocks will do better from now on, but judging from the bank statement of Saturday, the money market will bear watching; as also will the crop news from time to time, says a reliable Boston house.

The local stocks remain about the same. The trading is confined to National, Globe Consolidated, Superior & Boston. These stocks are cheap and will also be a good advance.
