TUCSON, Ariz., October 3.—Brewster Cameron arrived in Tucson Saturday on business from El Paso and made his stay very brief.

Mr. Cameron is at present spending considerable time in El Paso, where he is interested in some land adjoining the city, valued at approximately \$150,000. His visit to Arizona at this time was with regard to some of his private business affairs in Tucson.

About three weeks ago a report emanated from Washington that Brewster Cameron's name had been suggested as the next appointee as governor of Arizona and that his candidacy had been endorsed by prominent Republicans of the territory and also Pennsylvania and other eastern states.

When seen by a Star man Mr. Cameron was inclined to treat the subject as entirely foreign to his thoughts and when pressed for a statement, finally said:

"The suggestion that I am to be appointed governor of Arizona is new to me. Information which I have gathered is to the effect that Governor Kibbey is to remain in office."
